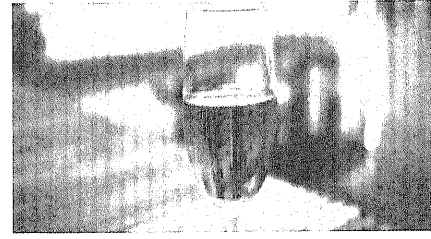

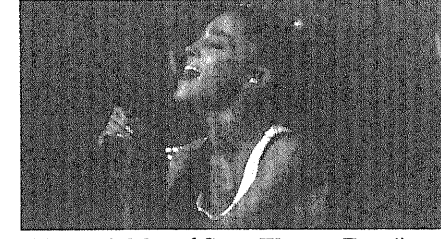

CSI's Deaf Professor Proves It's Possible to do the "Impossible"

Katina White Doesn't Let Others' Opinions Stop Her

CSI's Adjunct Professor, Katina White,

has been told that she can't go on to pursue higher education, to which she proved

them wrong.

"My mom told me, back then," White

began, smiling, "that the doctor told her that I would never go past a community college. And I've gotten as far as graduate school."

Sitting behind the desk at the World Languages Office in 2S-109, she is eager to be questioned. While focusing, she observes her environment without looking away, signing while speaking, but quick to respond.

"She is always attentive and caring," says her fellow co-tutor Briana Kelly.

Katina White, a 39-year-old Adjunct Professor working at CSI for the past 10 years was born hearing, but diagnosed as deaf at six.

"Before six," she mentions, "my mom saw me playing with toys. She tried to call my name and noticed that I wasn't answering her."

From Jamaica but born in Brooklyn, Katina White is known to be a "social butterfly" despite her loss of hearing.

She is well-known with her friends

Samiha Charles Looks to Writing & Sculpting as a Release

From being the awkward kid as a child, to looking up her sister and removing one, Samiha Charles has used writing and art to express her emotions while quiet.

"I was always the weird kid in my class," Charles said in response to an email. "I'd just stay by myself and write or play with dirt."

Now, when the 20-year-old student realizes that her clay is running out, or her sculpting tools are becoming dull, she goes to the nearest Michaels to purchase new items. The price never bothered her; it never amounted to the invaluable effect it had on her: producing something "that really looks good."

This piece of art that ends up looking really good, has been a benefiting factor for Charles, as it has developed her to enjoy-

ing time being spent alone while being the odd one out and living to her fullest potential within the midst of chaos.

"Like my mother once told me, 'if you're going to be a shoe shiner, be the best shoe shiner you could be,'" Charles said.

Samiha Charles is a Haitian-American student who was born and raised in Staten Island. Her parents "sheltered" Charles and her other three siblings - one brother and two sisters.

"I was known for being a homebody," Charles said when describing her childhood.

The sheltering eventually led to her not being able to socialize with her fellow classmates as they had playdates and hangouts.

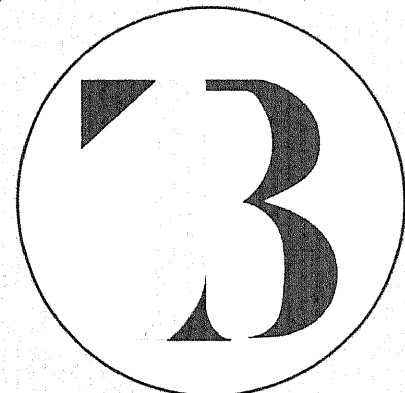

Who is Presidential Candidate Andrew Yang?

Andrew Yang Is Slowly Becoming Popular

The 2020 presidential election has kicked off with many Democrats running to become the Democratic nominee and challenge President Donald Trump. From current Senators like Bernie Sanders and Kamala Harris to rising liberal stars like Beto O'Rourke and Pete Buttigieg, a lot of candidates are trying to get their message across to the American people.

One candidate who did not initially get the media's attention, but is starting to gain attention is Andrew Yang, an entrepreneur and founder of Venture of America who was named "Champion of Change" by President Barack Obama's White House in 2012. With his supporters nicknamed the Yang Gang, Yang is slowly becoming well known to the American people.

The biggest issue Yang is running on is universal basic income. He wants everyone 18 and older to receive \$1000 a month, no matter how rich or poor they are.

While some have argued it could lead to socialism, Yang's counter-argument is that universal basic income would help capitalism. He believes it will create more jobs and entrepreneurs, which will help grow the economy according to Yang and a study from the Roosevelt Institute.

Yang supports capitalism, but wants to reform it so more people can benefit from it, calling it human-center capitalism. This is different from other Democrats who have embraced socialism more recently like Congresswoman Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez and Senator Sanders.

Yang also became well-known when he said he was against circumcision. He later softened his stance, saying he supports any decisions parents will make about circumcision.

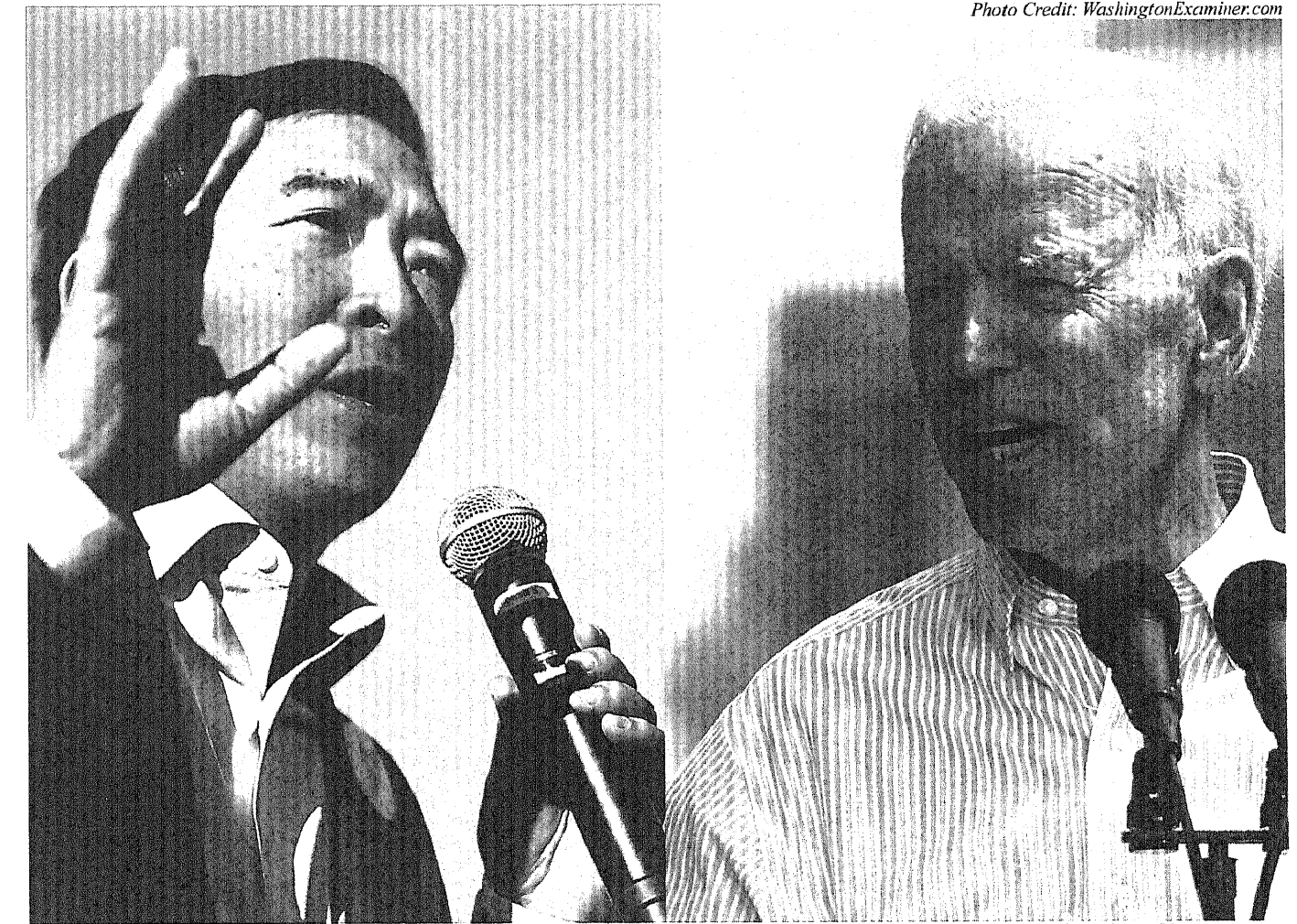

This disappointed inactivists, who are also referred to as anti-circumcision activists.

For immigration, Yang supports a pathway to citizenship for undocumented immigrants. He also supports securing the border, lowering the number of people entering the U.S. illegally, and increasing security in ports of entry where many drugs can come to the United States.

Yang wants to pass the DREAM Act, which is supposed to help illegal immigrants who were brought to the United States as children and know it as their only

home. Yang wants to put an end to partisan gerrymandering. He believes both Republicans and Democrats have been drawing the maps to benefit themselves.

Yang also believes Puerto Rico and Washington D.C. should become official states of the United States.

He supports other ideas that have been thrown around by candidates such as lowering the voting age to 16, enacting 'Medicare for All', and making Election Day an official holiday.

Unlike other Democrats to want to get

rid of the Electoral College, Yang supports keeping it, believing it is important to balance the voice of different regions. He is also open to making changes and admits it is not perfect.

What makes Yang different from most of the other candidates is he has not focused on President Trump as the main issue. Yang has repeatedly said his main focus is to solve the problems that helped get President Trump elected.

If Yang gets the Democratic nomination, he would become the first Asian-American to become a presidential nominee. If Yang beats President Trump, he would be the first Asian-American to become President of the United States and one of the youngest presidents to ever get elected.

Despite growing in support and popularity, Yang is behind in the polls. Others like Sanders and Joe Biden are leading by a lot.

Yang does qualify for the first two primary debates as of April 16. To qualify, candidates must have a certain number of donors and at least 1% in a few polls from qualifying polling organizations.

The primary debates will give Yang an opportunity to share his message to all Americans. Yang has already participated in many town halls and even appeared on conservative commentator Ben Shapiro's Daily Wire to discuss his run.

With a crowded field of candidates, it will be interesting to see how far Yang will go and if he can contend with bigger names like Biden and Sanders.

Although she enjoys dancing, she realizes her dream is to bring awareness to hearing people that deaf people exist too, through teaching American Sign Language.

She finished her Bachelor's degree at CSI, but received her Master's in Education at Columbia University, hoping to continue.

Despite the successes White experienced, she mentions her life isn't always full of ups, including the sudden passing of her younger brother, Junior.

She describes it as "isolating" as she had to sit in the front of her classes but feels relieved when her interpreter comes to help.

Professor Katina White now teaches American Sign Language classes at CSI and has students who have benefitted from it.

Former student of White and current master's student, Meagan Edwards explains that she's "expressive" and "provides extra tutoring if needed."

"Katina ensures that her students not only have an understanding of the language, but the culture behind it as well. Her class was actually easier compared to my previous professors."

Another student of her currently taking her class, Kymani Campbell, first judged a book by its cover.

"When I first applied for ASL 112, I thought my professor would be strict. I looked her up on Rate My Professor and the results weren't so good. In addition, her syllabus seemed bizarre."

Then he realized he was greatly mistaken.

"Compared to before, I noticed she cares a lot about her students." Both students agreed that they would take her again if they could.

Looking back and seeing now, Katina has no regrets, informing others to "have hope." She joked, "I wish I could just see that doctor and say, 'look at me now!'"

The "awkwardness" thus made young Samiha unapproachable and has followed her like a puppy follows its owner throughout her life.

It happened to be the little things that had an impact on the life of Samiha Charles, both in terms of quality and quantity.

"Even the simplest things in life, like talking, has had an impact on me," said Charles.

When it came to her choice of friends, Charles explained that she always found herself in "just a small group." When ordering food, it was a little amount.

Even when she began creating artwork, her work started off small. Literally.

for her. The monetary gains from the opportunity could've given it to her, but "it was not worth it."

Along with that, her oldest sister began to depart from the family.

"When I started high school, my oldest sister became estranged for petty reasons," said Charles. "There were times where I frustrated myself trying to figure out how or why it happened that I'd have my own meltdowns. But I realized that some things are just not worth wasting your time and energy or emotions with and sometimes you've just got to let things fall into place on their own."

However, she saw the example of her immediate sister, who declared her major in Journalism when she also attended college.

Seeing her sister's happiness and dedication to the field instilled the same passion in Charles and caused her to pursue the same career, along with her prior interest in writing since she was young.

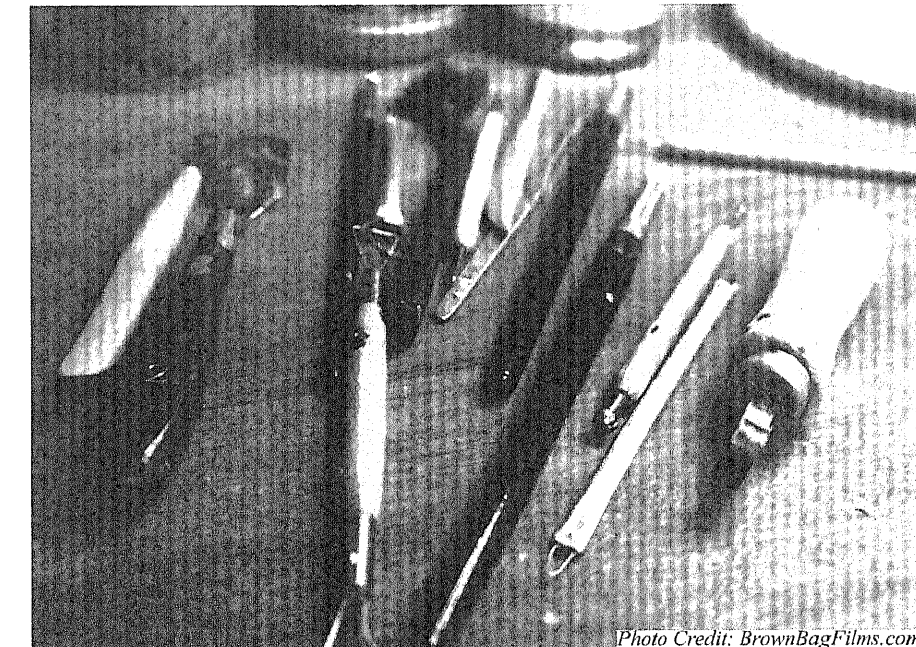

Charles "never stayed doing the same things." She saw art as a way to portray her situations through characters that she creates with clay and sculpting.

The student has currently a new Instagram page mainly the displaying of her artwork.

Her artwork has a devilish, demonic style to it, as most of them are red with horns.

She names each character as they do also come with their own personal background.

"Seeing how my family struggle as hard as we did, going through hardships and countless other events that's happened to us," Samiha said.

"How they've shielded me from watching family relatives become snakes and all the extra lengths they've gone through just to shield me from dealing with whatever hardships we went through."

Family has had a great impact on Charles, but she has been an example to herself to adapt to coping mechanisms to assist in dealing with anxiety attacks that the student has faced.

The Communications major, through her forms of art, wants to let others know it's okay to be shy or awkward: "It's what makes you, you."

"I'd like to be that impact that encourages others to uplift each other regardless of any situation and to encourage each other."

Samiha continues, "My mother once told me that 'as a black woman in America, there is no time to cry and feel sorry for yourself. It's time to put on your boxing gloves and continue to fight life.'"

According to the student, such is possible with the use of studying oneself, finding encouragement, and using the right tools.

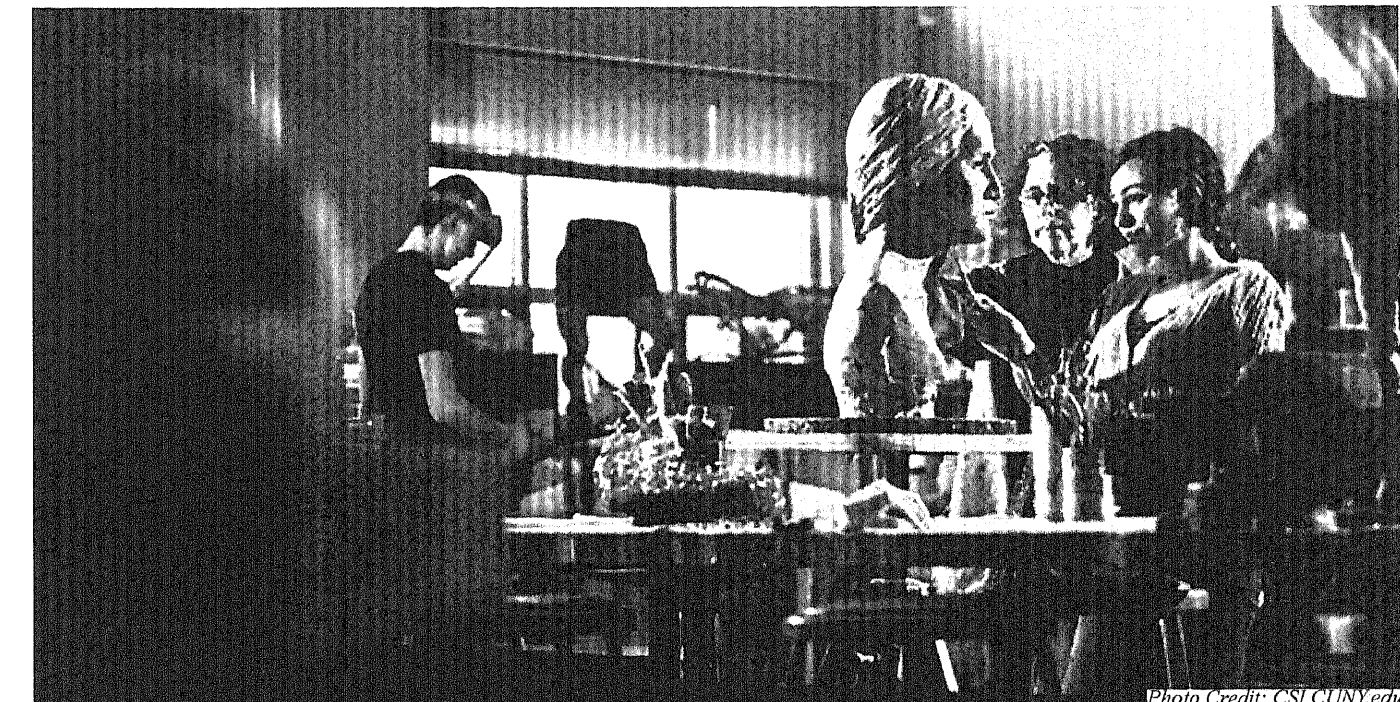

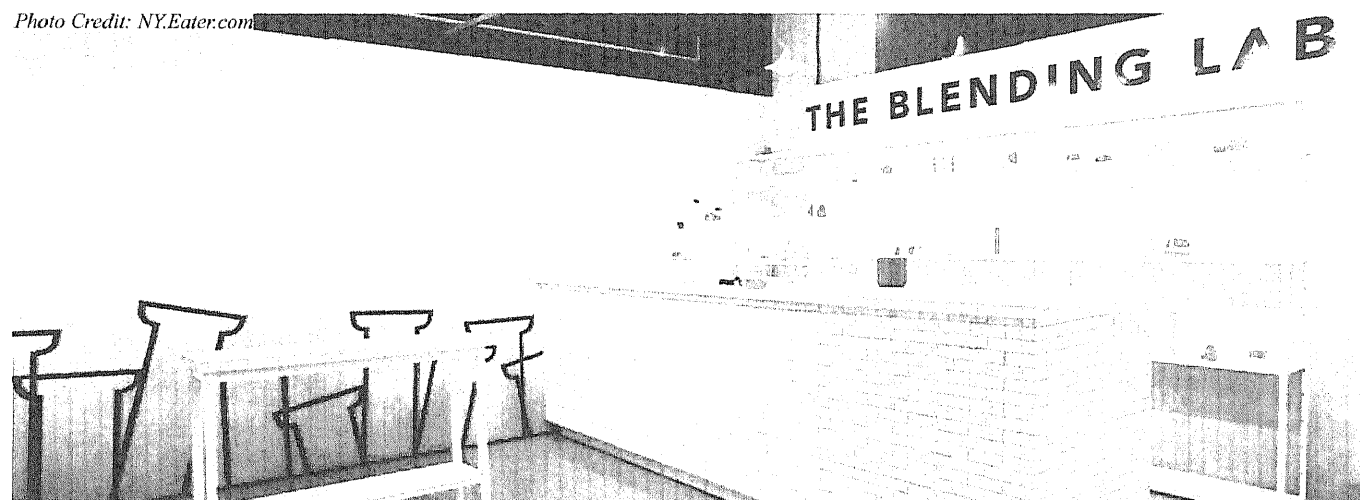
This pop-up store is a combination of three amazing experiences all in one. It's a wine bar, an amusement park and will be The Museum of Science for Wine.

Seven Intense Apartment-Friendly Arm Workouts

Workout Routines for Anyone, No Matter the Place

The quickest way to go the gym is to not go at all—and make your home your gym space instead.

You don't need fancy equipment either, or any equipment at all. There is a surplus amount of underutilized workout routines that can be done at home just as soon as you wake up, brush your teeth, and have a granola bar as a pre-breakfast warm up.

All these moves have been retracted from Cassey Ho at Blogilates, check her out! Let's start our countdown.

Our first workout move is dubbed, "Angel Wings". For this workout, imagine you're an elegant goddess and stand (or sit) as upright as possible.

Stretch both arms out to your sides. With a fluttering motion in your wrists and hands, like and angels wings, swiftly raise your arms towards the top of your head.

Go back to your starting position, and repeat. If desired, you can choose to do this one arm at a time. You can also switch up the speed for an added kick.

Keeping a theme of divinity, next is the "Prayer Pulse". Like a prayer, your hands should be pressed against each other, but also, the entirety of your forearms are symmetrically together and directly in front of you as best as at a 90-degree angle as you can get.

Following this resting stance, with elbows touching, pulse upward a few inches. Though seemingly simple, this exercise is killer; the pressure feels as if you're carrying weights. To push yourself, go slightly higher.

A third workout move is the "Pinky Propellers." Like an Egyptian princess, place your hands in an "okay" position.

Keep your palms facing up (or down, if that's more comfortable), keeping your pinkies out. Place your arms by your sides in a resting upright position at a 90-degree angle and in a quick motion, bring them in together in front of you, touching pinkies. Repeat this.

To add variation and work out other arm muscle groups, go backwards and touch pinkies behind your head.

Fourth workout move is the "Golf Balls." Though this sounds sexual, this workout is full of grit. Consider it a play on the small-circle/big-circle exercises you might remember doing in high school.

With your elbows down and arms at your sides, make a "V" shape with each arm. Hands flat out, motion your arms either forward or backward in a quick circular effect as if you're juggling golf balls.

Gauge your arms with the fifth workout move, known as the "Triangle Pushes." In this workout move, you are to go into a prayer pose. Like a true queen, silence your subjects gracefully with command by pushing your hands outward.

Not to be taken lightly, you should be pressing your palms together throughout this work out and pushing your hands forward with steady control. Feel the firmness through your centered structure.

The net work out is called the "Back Behinds." Your arms are following a two-step pattern with this exercise. For your starting position, place your arms flat out

on each side, palms facing down.

To transition, your hands turn over as your elbows reach behind your back so that your upper arms are in a "V" shape nearly parallel to your sides. To reach the full potential of this workout, squeeze your upper back muscles in the area between your shoulder blades.

Last but not least is the "Walnut Crushers." Place your arms in an acute-to-right angle, and like most of these workouts, your arms are by your side. Clench your hands tight, as if you were crushing walnuts.

Then dip your arms up, like the shape of a mini-rainbow, in small motions slightly forward and slightly backwards. Be sure to press down with intention and grip the invisible walnuts well so that your gauging your arm muscles.

Tattoos in the Workplace

Expression of Art or Destruction of Professionalism?

When Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. said men should be judged by the content of their character, rather than the color of skin, he was clearly talking about race. However, in recent years a debate has erupted over the appropriateness of tattoos in the workplace.

Some believe it is a reflection of bad judgement and is not suited for the workplace, while others think it should not be an issue, so long as the employee can fulfill their workplace tasks.

Personally, I believe tattoos should remain hidden throughout the workday, if

possible, since there are professional standards that should be upheld.

The American Academy of Pediatrics stated that millennials are flocking to tattoo parlors in higher numbers than any generation before them.

According to the same study, attitudes towards tattoos are changing rapidly. The publication stated that twenty-nine percent of people believed there was a link between tattoos and "deviant behavior" in 2008, but as of 2012, that figure dropped to twenty four percent.

The reason for this drop is unknown, however some suspect it is because of body art's increasing popularity.

As tattoos become more popular, inevitably tattooed employees become more popular. In 2019, most millennials have already graduated college and ready to enter the workforce.

Would You Buy A House From Someone Who Can't Let Go?

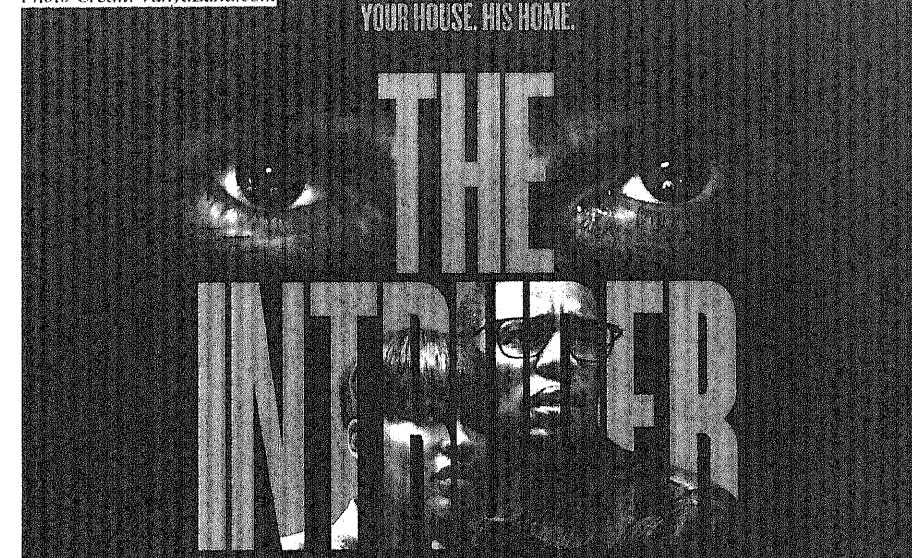

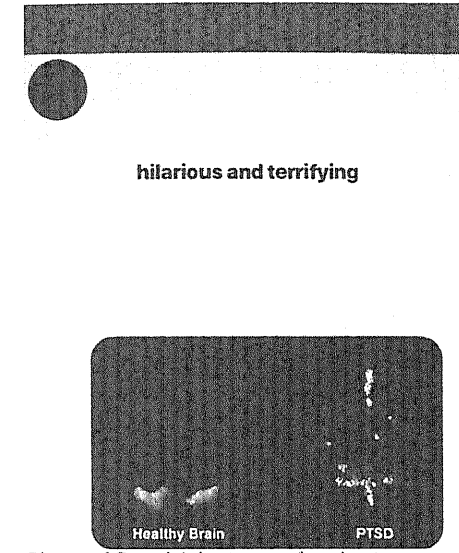

PTSD Scans of Ariana Grande's Brain Shocks Fans The Reality of Trauma for One of America's Most Beloved Singers Hits Fans

Post-traumatic stress disorder can happen to anyone, even to one of the world's most notable recording artists, Ariana Grande.

The 25-year old singer, songwriter, and actress shared a recent post on Instagram showing an authentic scan of her brain after the recent loss of ex-boyfriend, Mac Miller, break up with SNL comedian, Pete Davidson, and Manchester attack of two years ago.

The pictures allegedly showed the scan of a healthy brain followed by that of one affected by PTSD. Under that was a scan of her brain, which looked startlingly similar to the scan of the brain with PTSD.

In response to her Instagram post, Grande insisted that this was in no way to be taken lightly and that the scans of her brain were real.

Fans and devoted followers of

Grande's musical career, for the most part, seem to be under the consensus that the trauma associated with the Manchester concert bombing in 2017 and the backlash received from the media blaming her for the death of Mac Miller, took a toll on her mental health.

Also, with the added stress of not only consistently being on tour, but having to deal with one tragedy after another in such a short span of time, there is evidence to

intense the trauma is, the more likely it is for someone to develop PTSD, no matter the age.

Symptoms of PTSD include having intrusive thoughts that interfere with daily activities, a strong avoidance for anything related to the traumatic event, persistent negative feelings, and engaging in impulsive and/or reckless behavior. As everyone's case is unique, not everyone with PTSD experiences the same symptoms.

In order to be diagnosed with PTSD, symptoms must last for more than a month. Other conditions can also accompany PTSD, such as depression, substance abuse disorder, memory problems and other physical ailments.

Despite internet skeptics and unsympathetic Hollywood critics, Ariana Grande stands as a pillar of strength for people battling similar mental health issues. She has become an inspiration for people by inspiring others through her honesty in sharing her mental health challenges and persistence in making music despite her daily struggles with PTSD.

In light of Grande's struggles with mental health, her fans are urging her to

take some time off from music and touring to properly heal.

One fan wrote on Twitter, "It's not shocking that Ariana puts up a strong front up to a crowd when she's still struggling and suffering from trauma and PTSD from Manchester and other situations she was sadly involved in. I just hope she doesn't overwork herself and drain herself anymore mentally/physically."

Due to the overwhelming amount of responses to her post, Grande made a response on Instagram stating, "Didn't mean to startle anyone with my brain thingy. I love science and seeing the physical reality of what's going on in there was incredible to me. Someday, when I'm more healed up, we can talk more about it."

Grande's struggles with PTSD has brought up the importance of mental health awareness and how caring for it should be made a priority. Cases like these also show that despite the fame and fortune celebrities have, they are susceptible to trauma just as much as their fans.

In the meantime, fans hope that Grande will eventually be able to make a significant recovery and return to her normal self.

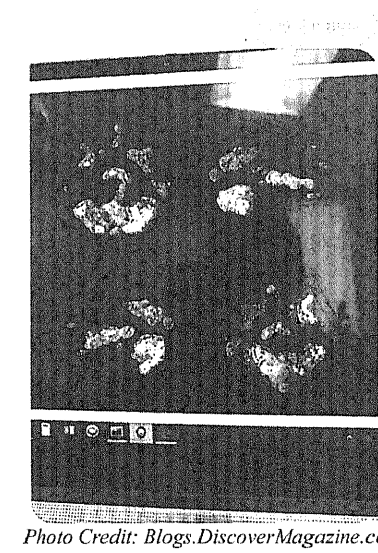

to hide his feelings from Julie. Michael makes advances on Julie, making her think that Dorothy is a lesbian.

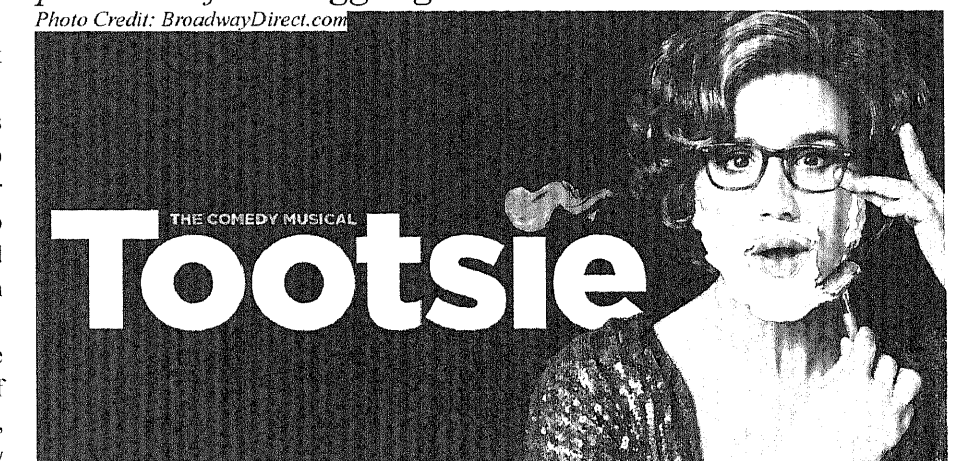

Characters in "Friday the 13th" movies who have been in relationships of lust have never survived. Usually, they are the first one's killed off.

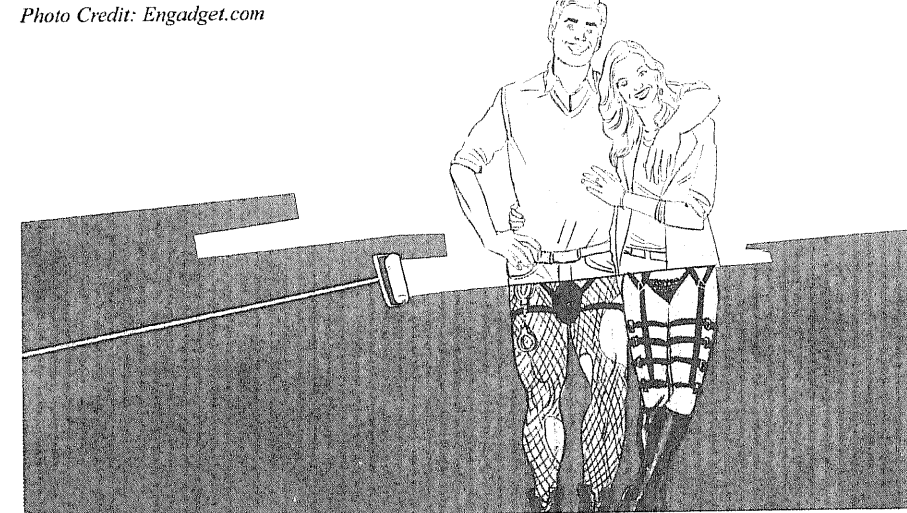

Selfishness often cannot be stopped and will invade into your system. Either gender can cheat on their partner just to feel good and satisfy something that they believe their current partner can't give them.

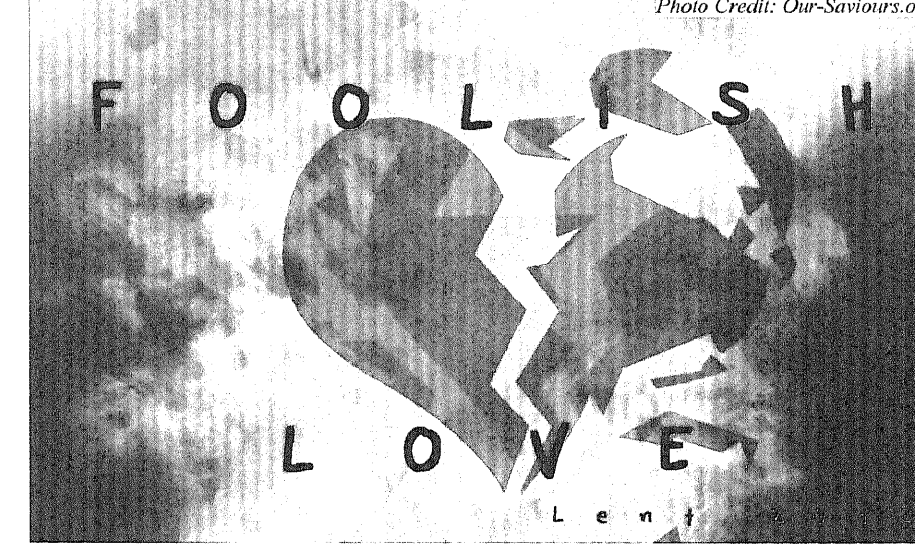
Is it really worth it to destroy the relationship you guys had built up for years for a third wheel?

Do You Masturbate for Dopamine or Just because You're Horny?

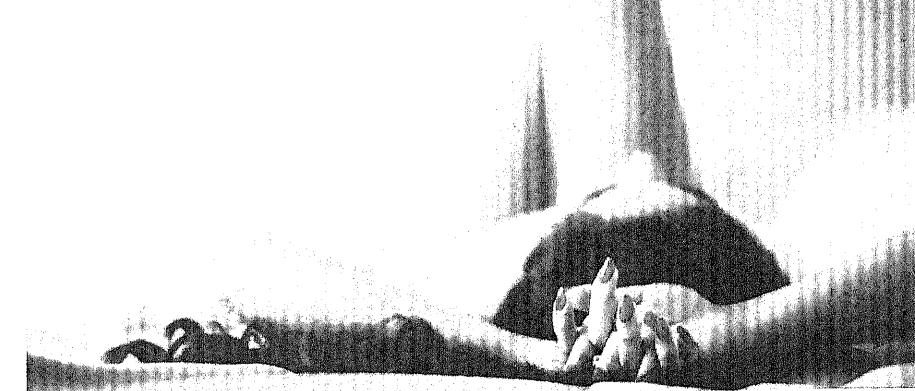

Right now, The Warriors are taking on The Houston Rockets where they lost their last game to the Rockets in a tough overtime loss, yet they still lead the series two games to one.

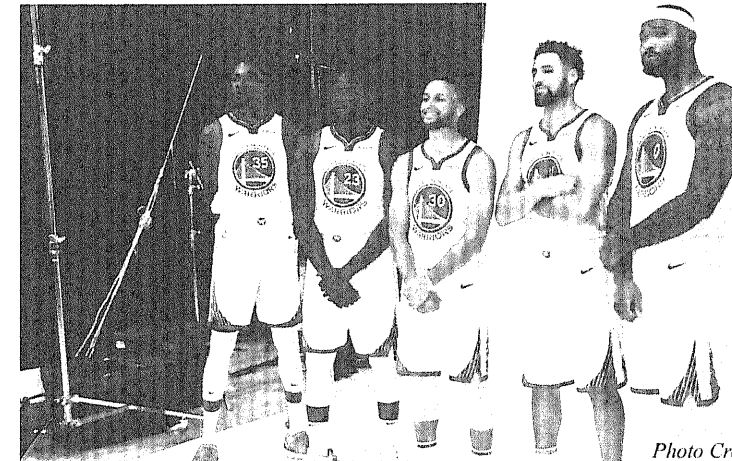
The Rockets have shown they are capable of taking on The Warriors, but they aren't the only team who has shown they can compete with them as well.

Cody's response on Twitter was simple and to the point, "I'll take that bet, Dave."

And the rest was history. The first event that laid the foundation for All Elite Wrestling premiered live three months later and was called All In. It took place on September 1st, 2018 and was held in the Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates, Illinois.

Selling out in thirty minutes after ap-

pearing online, All In had the largest audience for a professional wrestling event since 1993 that wasn't WWE or WCW affiliated. The venue was packed with 11,263 seats sold. Some had to be left at the door.

With such matches as Cody Rhodes fighting Nick Aldis for the NWA World Heavyweight Championship and Pentagon Jr. duking it out with Kenny Omega for the first time ever, no wonder AEW's first show knocked it out of the ballpark.

Fast forward to the present moment and fans of professional wrestling are still hanging on to the edge of their seats when it comes to AEW.

On May 25th, Cody, Matt and Nick, along with now named CEO, Shahid

Khan, are hosting another event. This one is called Double or Nothing and will take place in the MGM Grand in Las Vegas. Besides being a billionaire, Khan is not only the owner of the Jacksonville Jaguars but the Fullham F.C. in the English Premier League. A financial backing seems to no longer be a concern in this game.

The matches presented this time are a sight to behold as well. Cody Rhodes is fighting his real life brother, Dustin Rhodes, formerly known as Goldust in WWE, who is now donning a red and black face paint.
