We feel that the Establishment of this system has neglected to meet in any meaningful way the continually expressed concerned and criticisms of many students.

The dehumanizing irrelevant academic, an administrative procedure: perpetuated by the administration and the faculty can only begin to be reversed by immediate implementation of the following demands:

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1. Equal student representation with all (due) rights on all standing committees and commissions. Students must have a primary role in the decision making bodies of the University;
2. Make College Discovery a separate department with all privileges of a standing dept with voting and representation on the P & B;
3. No requirements--leaving this issue up to the discretion of (NES) STUDENTS WITH COMPREHENSIVE COUNSLERING and advisment;
4. There must be an end to the present tenure system;
5. That the ethnic and urban studies program be put into practice;
6. Give students credits for work done at both on and off campus Day Care Center. This is to include any Community Service preformed by a student;
7. The Financial Aide Office take positive steps to insure its image in the eyes of the student and prove themselves knowledge of the problem of non--white students;
8. A (Student) Financial Aides Review Board with complete control of students finances be set up by the student government. In order to set up a (student) Financial Aide Review Board, members should be elected at Student Government elections.
