The Little King

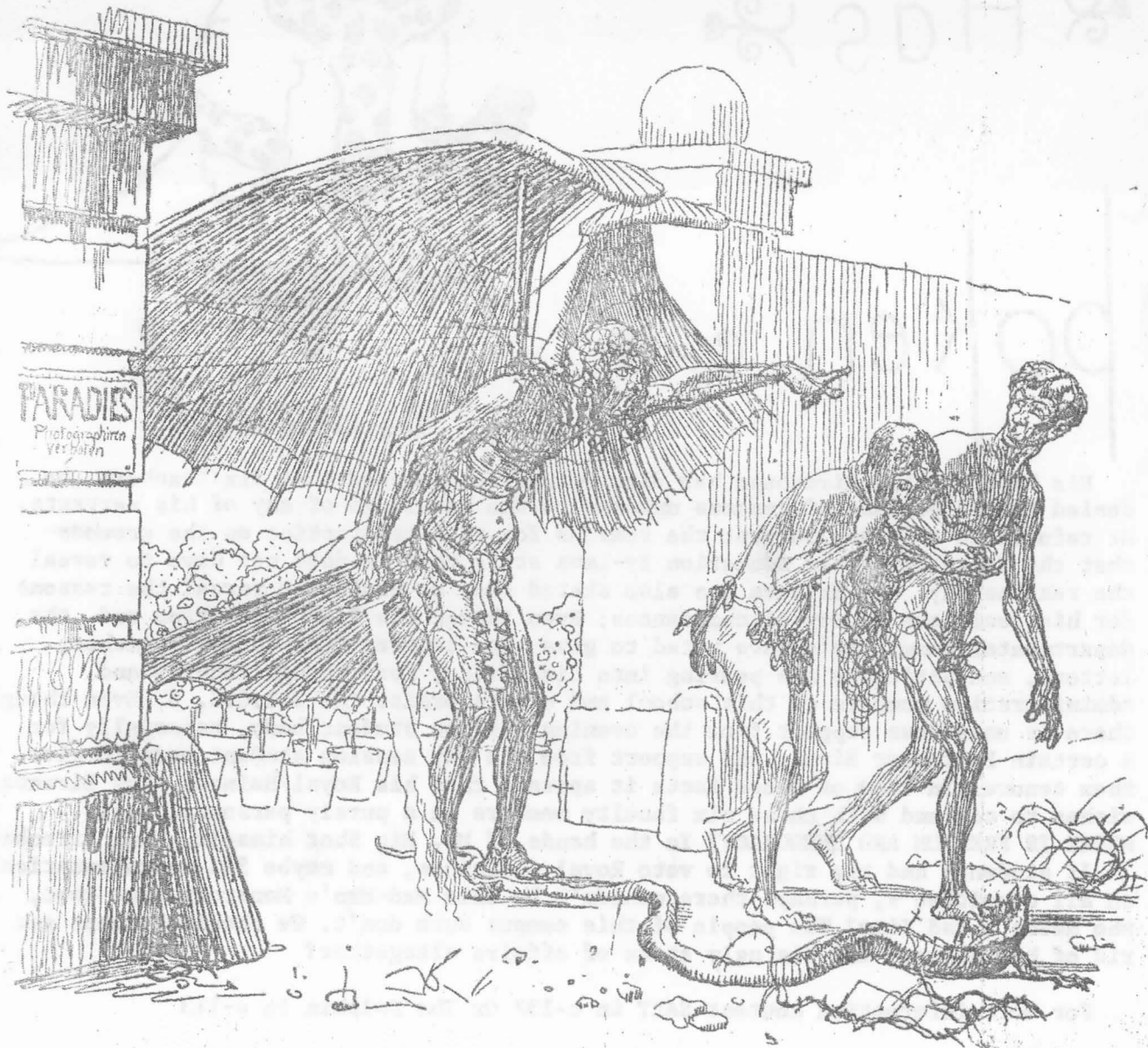
