Supervision Certificates Given 3 at Willowbrook

Certificates for completion of courses in supervision were presented to three employes of Willowbrook State School at a meeting Saturday of the school's Board of Visitors in Building 1, on grounds of the institution.

The awards, from the New York State Civil Service Commission and Cornell University's School of Industrial and Labor Relations, were made by former Municipal Court Justice C. Ernest Smith president of the board, to Frederick F. Carroll, food service manager; Malcolm Johnson, motor equipment foreman and John F. Hagan, supervising attendant.

The course, entitled, "Case Studies in Supervision," is part of a training program for personnel selected by Dr. Harold H. Berman, director of the school.
