The products, which include woodwork, needlecraft and embroidered items in addition to all types of rugs, have been made by upwards of 700 children in classes under the direction of Mrs. Lulu Aden Larsen, senior occupational therapist.

The program is aimed at developing good habits in the children in addition to enabling them to become socially adequate and occupationally competent, reports Mrs. Larsen.

Proceeds from the sale will be used for the purchase of materials

needed for further occupational therapy work. More than 1,000 items will be on display.
