

Rev. Daniel Quinn, 42, Willowbrook Chaplain

The Rev. Daniel I. Quinn, the first Catholic chaplain of Willowbrook State School, died yesterday in St. Clare's Hospital, Manhattan, after an illness of a few weeks. He was 42 years old.

Father Quinn was assigned to the school in 1951, as he had shown an interest in mentally deficient children in Bellevue Hospital. A devoted worker, he organized a choir and religious program among the children of the school and a Rosary Society and Holy Name Society among the personnel. He lived in St. Michael's Home, Greenridge.

Father Quinn was ordained in St. Patrick's Cathedral, Manhattan, in 1933, after graduating from Cathedral College, Manhattan, and St. Joseph's Seminary, Dunwoodie, N. Y. He subsequently served as an assistant in parishes in Brewster, and Poughkeepsie, N. Y. and in Resurrection and Sacred Heart of Jesus and Mary churches in Manhattan.

Surviving are his parents, Daniel and Catherine Quinn; a brother, John, and a sister, Miss Catherine Quinn, all of Bronx.

A requiem mass will be offered Wednesday at 10:30 A. M. in St. Patrick's Cathedral, where a divine office will be sung tomorrow at 3:30 P. M. The funeral will be from the Skelly and Larney Funeral Home, 222 East 31st street, Manhattan.
