

SCME Fights Union-Busting at Willowbrook

The presidents and officers of 10 local unions representing employees in state mental institutions held a demonstration on June 2 at Willowbrook State School, Staten Island, in protest against what Al Wurf, Assistant Regional Director, called "union-busting" and "labor spy" policies of Dr. Harold H. Berman, director of the institution.

The 10 local unions that staged the rally "in support of our union brothers in Willowbrook" are affiliated with New York State Employees Council 50, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.

Wurf accused Dr. Berman with being in "constant violation" of the Governor's executive order on labor relations and with "reflecting the union-busting conspiracy which resulted in the current strike against six New York City voluntary hospitals.

Anti-Labor Policy

"If his hysterical anti-labor, employee-hating policies are any index, Dr. Berman apparently has appointed himself a Committee-of-One to wreck state labor codes and envisions himself as masterminding an anti-union drive in the Department of Mental Hygiene," Wurf added.
