Damage Toll Climbs In Wake of Storm



EMERGENCY SERVICE—Manhattan firemen, members of the department's special engineering bureau, man pumps to empty about a million gallons of water from the powerhouse at Willowbrook State School where 12 feet of water threatened to shut off electrical service at the institution.

WATER rose to 12 feet in the pump room of the Willowbrook State School powerhouse, threatening for a time the electric control panel at the 6,000-patient in-
