Interfaith Religious Center Planned at State School

Plans are under way for an interfaith religious center to be built on the grounds of Willowbrook State School with private funds.

The building would contain a chapel for each of the three major faiths, office space, classrooms and an area for social functions.

The drive for funds will be highlighted by a benefit din-

ner celebrating the 50th anniversary in show business of Al Kelly, a double talk artist, next Nov. 1 at the Astor Hotel, Manhattan.

The dinner is being sponsored by Jackie Bright, Kelly's manager, and all proceeds will be turned over to the Interfaith Religious Center of Willowbrook State School, an organization formed to raise the money and

build the center.

Heading the drive for the center are the three chaplains at Willowbrook, Rabbi Philip Goldberg; the Rev. Arnold E. Ostlund and the Rev. Edward J. Banks.
