

State School Board

Votes New President

William M. Braybrooks of Holsman Rd., Grymes Hill, yesterday was elected president of the Board of Visitors of Wil-lowbrook State School at the annual meeting at the Staten Is-land institution.

Braybrooks succeeds former Municipal Court Judge C. Ernest Smith who has been president for more than 15 years. Smith

was named to the post by former Gov. Dewey when the board was established in June, 1950. He did not seek reelection.

The new president was named to the board by former Gov. Harriman in March, 1957. He

was reappointed to the board last year by Gov. Rockefeller.

Braybrooks, who retired as general manager of the Gulfport terminal of the Gulf Oil Corp., was president of the Staten Is-land Chamber of Commerce in 1947 and 1948.

Mrs. Jerome O. Ellis of Don-gan Hills was reelected secretary of the board.
