Overcrowding at Willowbrook State School, the country's largest institution for the retarded, will be reduced as more than 700 patients are transferred to the new Suffolk State School.

Willowbrook Director Jack Hammond said that "until Nov. 30, we will be transferring about 120 younger and physically handicapped children whose parents reside in Nassau and Suffolk Counties." He said that approximately 600 more will be transferred later.

New classrooms and ten prefabricated buildings at Willowbrook will be completed this month, and placed in use, further easing overcrowded conditions, Hammond said.
