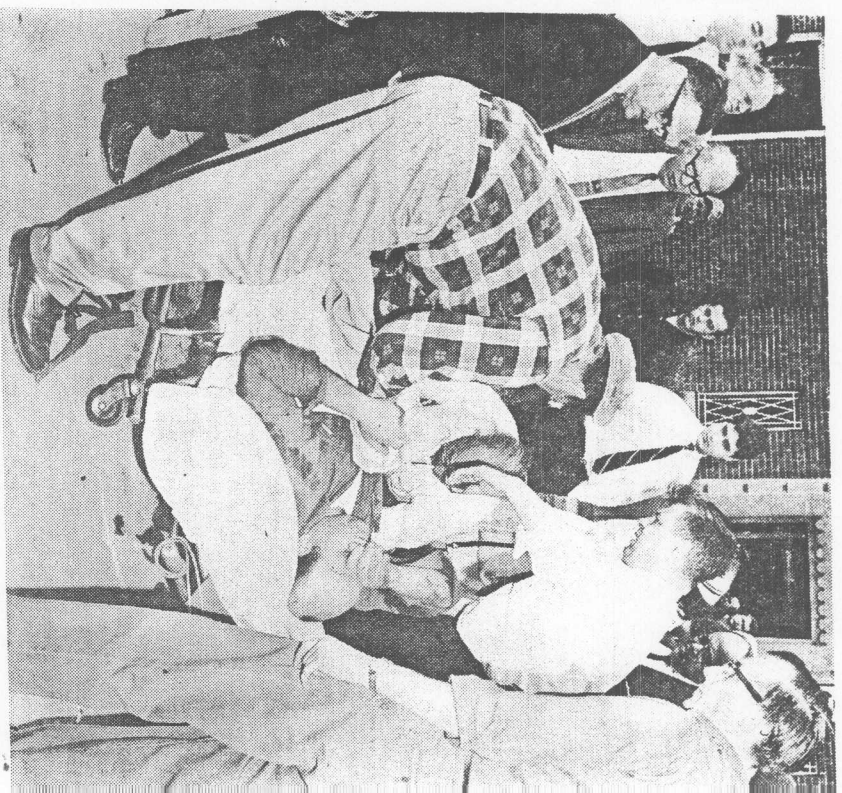




Near Tragedy . . .

Workmen help Harry Brickle of Brooklyn from a water main excavation ditch at Willowbrook State School after a pile of earth slid into the trench and buried him and another worker, Arthur Truscelli, 25, of 183 Lincoln Ave., Grant City, up to their chests. Coworkers dug both men out in less than 30 minutes.



. . . And Rescue

Brickle is wheeled to an ambulance at the scene. He was taken to St. Vincent Hospital where he was treated for injuries to his left ankle, right hip and groin and released. Truscelli was taken to the Willowbrook employees' infirmary, treated for injuries to his right foot and leg, and released.
