Applications open for nursing school

The School for Practical Nursing at Willowbrook State School is now accepting applications for the class to begin next fall, Miss Frances M. Ryan, principal of the school has announced.

An applicant, who may inquire further at the New York State Division of Employment, St. George, or at Willowbrook, must be between the ages of 18

and 50, have completed two years of high school and be in good health.

Upon successful completion of the program, the graduate is eligible to become licensed in the state by a State Board examination.

A student referred to the program by the Division of Employment receives a stipend of \$3,325 per year.
