Bail ordered for union aide in trespass

Bail of \$1,000 was fixed for a 31-year-old union representative at his arraignment yesterday in Criminal Court on charges of criminal trespass and obstructing a state administrator in connection with an incident that took place Nov. 27 at Willowbrook State School.

The defendant, Leamon Hood, a representative of Local 1184, Council 50 of the American Federation of State County and Municipal Employes, faces a trial on the counts Wednesday.

Judge Alfred J. Cawse set the bail after Hood refused to promise he would stay away from the institution until his trial is over.

Hood was issued a summons by special Patrolman Daniel Carlsen on a complaint by the institution's personnel director, Harold Margasin, who charged that Hood refused to leave the laundry room.

The confrontation took place as negotiations between the union and state officials on contract agreement were under way. The contract has since been settled.
