

Appointment made to Willowbrook board

Carlton H. Ettlinger of 119 Douglas Rd., Emerson Hill, has been appointed a new member of the Board of Visitors of Willowbrook State School by Governor Rockefeller.

Lee L. Landes, president of the board, has been reappointed for a seven-year term. Both appointments are subject to confirmation by the State Senate.

Republican County Chairman Richard H. Bolton reported that his office was advised of both appointments yesterday by the governor's office. Both board members are Republicans.

Ettlinger, who heads a firm of land surveyors on Staten Island, which bears his name, replaces on the eight-man

board C. Ernest Smith, whose term expired at the end of 1967.

Ettlinger's term expires in 1974.

Landes is director of college relations at Staten Island Community College.

The board of visitors inspects facilities at the Willowbrook State School periodically, consults with the medical director, and transmits information as to the needs of the institution to the governor and the Department of Mental Hygiene. It submits reports of its monthly meetings directly to the governor. The members serve without salary.
