

Neuberger raps Amann again

Jerome M. Neuberger, vice chairman of the Democratic County Committee, yesterday continued his verbal volley with Assemblyman Edward J. Amann Jr., accusing Amann of ignoring the conditions at Willowbrook State School.

"At the 1971 legislative session," Neuberger said in a prepared statement "our local legislators voted for budget cuts, including those for Willowbrook State School, which have severely hurt the patients. Would it not have been better not to vote for salary increases or 'lulus' and even vote to do away with 'lulus' in the interest of the poor unfortunate patients?"

"If you (Amann) are concerned with the conditions of Willowbrook," Neuberger asked, "why have you and your fellow Republican legislators filled your own pockets with increases and yet taken funds away from useful institutions?"
