The courageousness and the dedication of Dr. Wilkins and Mrs. Lee must not be allowed to falter because of our failure as citizens to demand that the deplorable conditions at Willowbrook be corrected.

It is not enough to us to "prove" that we are shocked and disgusted by the conditions under which our fellow hunter beines are living. We must commit our selves as deeply and as thoroughly as Dr. Wilkins, and Mrs. Lee and their co-workers.
