

Willowbrook unit to gain from shows

The Experimental Theater Company under the auspices of the Church of the Good Shepherd at 236 East 31st St., Manhattan will perform "JB" by Archibald Macleish at the church tomorrow through Thursday at 8 p.m. All proceeds from the performances will go to the Phase Out Willowbrook Committee.

That committee, which is still in the formative stages, is connected with the Benevolent Society for Retarded Children, an organization made up of parents with children institutionalized at Willowbrook.

The group hopes to raise enough money to decentralize the services offered by Willowbrook so that retarded children can be taken care of in halfway houses, foster homes and sheltered workshops.

Tickets for "JB" may be purchased at the Church of Good Shepherd from 1 to 6 p.m. today, or in the rectory office on nights of performances. They range from \$2.50 to \$5.
