Willowbrook gets \$192,740 grant

The Department of Health, Education and Welfare has awarded a \$192,740 grant to Willowbrook State School, it was announced yesterday in Washington by Congressman John M. Murphy's office.

The grant will be used to inaugurate "Project Exodus," a two-year study of health, vocational and emotional needs of every patient at Willowbrook. The goal of the project is to rehabilitate 2,000 residents and discharge them into smaller institutions or other social units outside the school.

The grant was presented to Dr. Manny Sternieht, director of Adult Rehabilitation Services at Willowbrook.
