

## Lost mental patient subject of appeal

Dr. Calvin A. Michael of the Williamsburg Residential and Training Center in Brooklyn has issued a special appeal for information concerning the whereabouts of a 20-year-old mentally retarded man who disappeared while visiting Willowbrook State School Sunday.

George Gonzales, an epileptic with an IQ of 45, is undergoing medication of Dolantin and phenobarbital three times a day. He may be subject to

seizures without the medication. When last seen the man, who is five feet five inches tall, was wearing a black ski jacket, red polo shirt, green striped slacks and black shoes. A Williamsburg official described him as "gentle and friendly but probably frightened." Gonzales speaks only broken English.
