Willowbrook death still being probed

Working with information from an autopsy report, the investigation into the death of a 13-year-old Willowbrook patient who died last Sunday is still going on, according to Detective William Morris of the homicide assault squad.

Dr. Milton Halpern, the city medical examiner, has disclosed that the victim, Tyrone Coruyo, died of "a subdural hemorrhage" which "could have resulted from a fall" as well as

something else.

A subdural hemmorhage is a brain injury. Police said they are investigating the death, which they termed not "overtly suspicious" because of recent reports of assaults on patients at Willowbrook. The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children is also active in the investigation and several arrests of Willowbrook personnel have resulted.
