## Camp begun at Willowbrook

Willowbrook State School has added a new day camp to its list of recreational programs.

The camp consists of about 50 residents from Unit Six which includes Buildings 21, 22 and 23. It meets for several hours during the day, Monday through Friday, and is staffed by summer employes as well as members of the regular staff.

The residents are involved in activities, including arts and crafts, physical exercise, hikes and picnics. Various trips to movies, restaurants and to the Staten Island Zoo are also being planned.

Linda Surowka, director of the camp, said that in selecting the participants for the camp, she tried to choose those not involved in other programs.
