

Willowbrook aides given summonses

Two Willowbrook State School employes were given summonses last night after, police said, one allegedly took a radio from a patient and the other interfered with a security guard who was attempting to apprehend the first.

Police said Michael Harris, 19, of Manhattan, was charged with petty larceny and resisting arrest while James Kelliehan, 25, of 48 Britton St., West Brighton, was charged with obstructing governmental administration. Both were issued summonses returnable Feb. 5 at Criminal Court, Stapleton.

According to police, Harris allegedly took a portable radio

from a patient around 6:30 p.m. and was apprehended by John Adiutori of the institution's security force a short time later. Police said Harris then broke away, but was caught a second time by Adiutori, after a brief chase.

As the security officer was attempting to subdue Harris, Kelliehan allegedly tried to interfere.
