

## Woman gets visitor post at Willowbrook

Mrs. Emma Coleman of 700 Victory Blvd., Silver Lake, was appointed to the board of visitors of Willowbrook State School, Governor Wilson's office announced yesterday.

Mrs. Coleman has been active with groups devoted to retarded children for about 10 years. Currently she is president of the Richmond Parent, Teachers and Friends of the Retarded and secretary of the board of Staten Island Aid for Retarded Children.

She served as chairman of the Staten Island Mental Retardation Regional Council from 1971 to 1973, is on the committee for the special olympics and a member of Staten Island Aid for Retarded Children Auxiliary.
