Every school on the Island had a Halloween party yesterday. Pupils, principals and teachers included — came through in fine style.

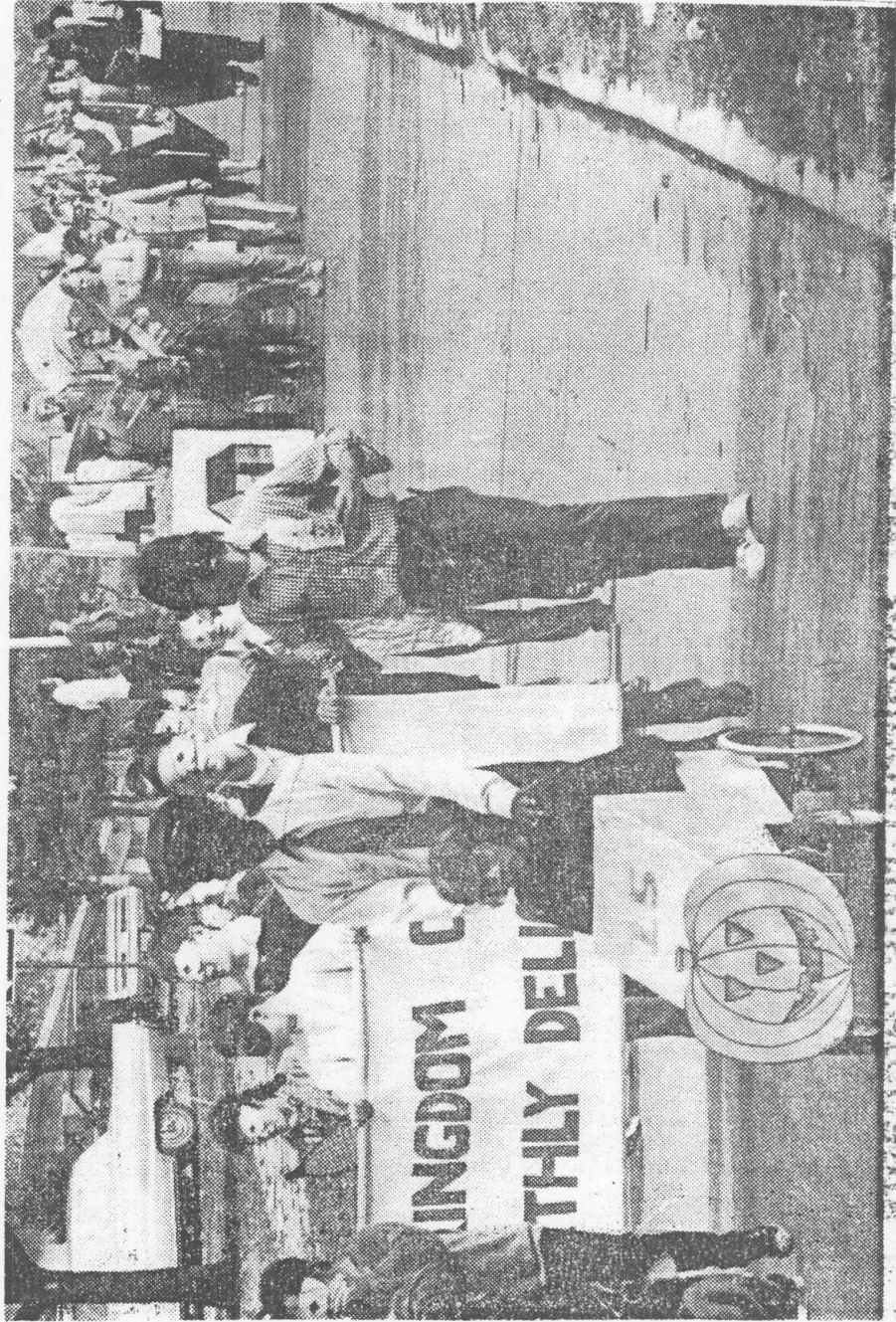
A few even had costume parades in the schoolyards, thanks to the fine weather, but the "granddaddies" of the parades had to be two, in-
