Testimony thus far in the case has revealed conditions at Willowbrook that have included mice and roaches infesting buildings and food; maggots infesting wounds on the bodies of patients; employes with severe drug problems, and general conditions that one witness said, cause "irreparable harm" to residents.

The explosive court testimony has proceeded while Willowbrook's former director Dr Miodrag Ristich, was trans ferred from his post and while James Forde, a management specialist, has taken over on ar interim basis.
