

Willowbrook girl's injury probed

Detectives are investigating an incident in which an 11-year-old Willowbrook Developmental Center patient was found in her crib with a broken finger and cuts on her face.

According to police, the girl, Lilly Sippy, was discovered by an attendant about 8:30 p.m. Saturday and was treated by a physician at the center.

Police said she suffered cuts of the face which required five stitches and a broken finger on her right hand.

Detectives were called into the investigation Saturday on a complaint by Barbara Villani, a team leader at Willowbrook.

A spokesman for the center refused to comment on the incident.
