
Willowbrook negotiations off till fall

The next meeting in the negotiations for an out-of-court settlement in the suit against Willowbrook Developmental Center has been set for Sept. 28, lawyers for Willowbrook parents said yesterday.

The scheduled Feb. 14 meeting was postponed when lawyers for the Office of the Counsel for the Governor asked for more time to prepare their version of the agreement that would end the three-year-old civil action.

The last round of talks were held on Jan. 31. At that time, Bruce Ennis of the New York Civil Liberties Union said that a settlement was possible but that significant differences still separated the two sides.
