

Missing woman may be found

Marguerite Sass, the 28-year-old severely retarded resident of Willowbrook Developmental Center who wandered away from a group attending a concert in Carnegie Hall and has been missing since Saturday, may have been found this morning.

According to Joyce Libra, a Willowbrook official, a woman fitting Miss Sass' description was discovered in the waiting room of Penn Central Station, "talking with one of the derelicts," according to a Penn Central police officer.

She was taken to Bellevue Hospital. Reports from the emergency room there said the patient was "dazed, but in relatively good condition, and hungry."

Miss Libra said she expected positive identification would be made this morning.
