

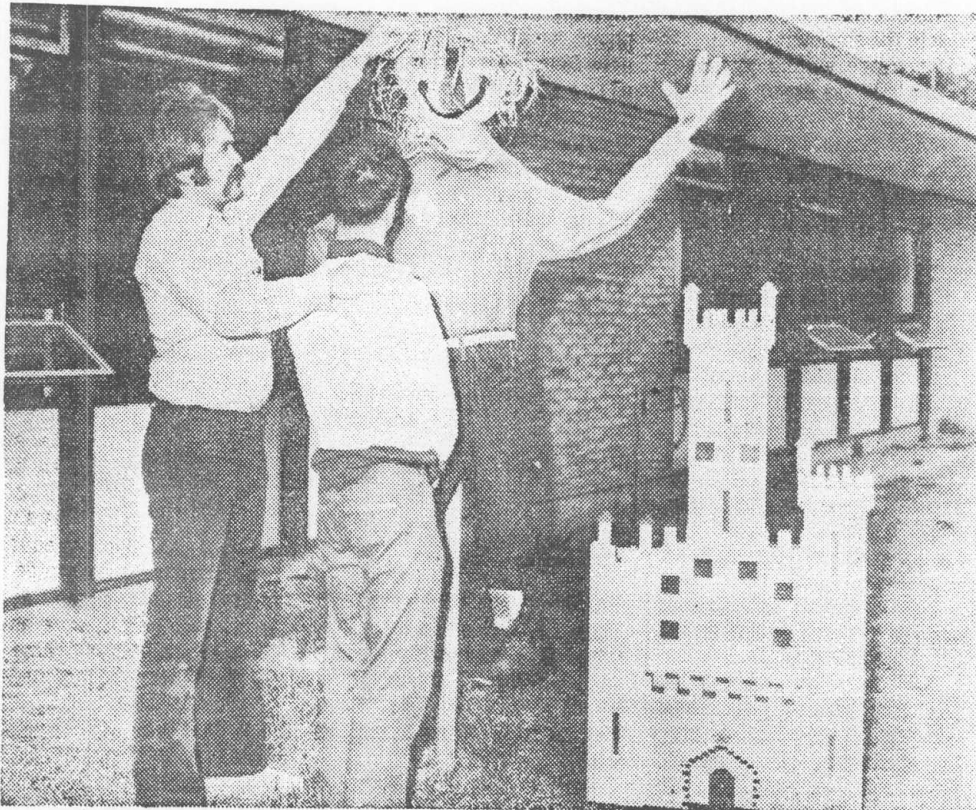
teachers hope to cut their own recordings and place the records in a jukebox which will play the educational stories.
