Willowbrook quiz slated by caucus

Assemblyman Arthur O. Eve, a Buffalo Democrat who chairs the Assembly's black and Puerto Rican Legislative Caucus, announced today that the caucus will investigate what he called "the tragic series of events at the Willowbrook Developmental Center."

Assemblyman Eve also said the caucus will form a special task force on mental hygiene to conduct the investigation.

Eve and members of the caucus had planned to tour Willowbrook today.

He was critical of what he called "many informational

gaps and inconsistencies surrounding the death of Luis Ramirez."

Ramirez, a Willowbrook resident, was missing for four days before his body was found Dec. 29 in a wooded area near the center's administration building.

Eve has asked Eager P. Smith, chairman of the patient care committee of the Sheraton Parents Association of the Manhattan Developmental Center, to head the task force.
