Hurricane whips by Island; rees, power lines toppled

However, he hesitated to issue a formal evacuation notice.

Although hundreds of Islanders, especially those in the Cedar Grove Beach section of New Dorp, heeded the commissioner's warnings, by far the largest evacuation was at the South Beach Psychiatric Center, where the removal of all the patients took place.

At 9 p.m., while the hurricane danger was still high, 252 patients, accompanied by st members, were loaded aborseven buses and transported Willowbrook Developmen Center, where arrangemen had been made to keep the patients overnight. Additional 40 cerebral palsy patient were also removed to Willobrook.

Earlier, the psychiatr center had discharged near 100 patients on 72-hour leave

Dr. Lawrence Sporty, depty director of the center, sa he based his decision to evacate on the advice of civil d fense officials, who predicte flooding of up to a foot o more in the area.

"We have no experient with which to weigh the sitution," Sporty explained "We'd rather do this this time and make a decision from distance than become completely isolated with no electricity or heat."
