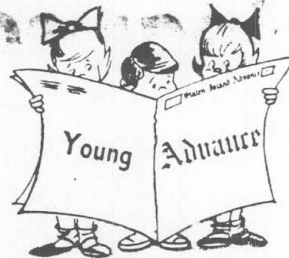

Carey visit

Gov. Hugh Carey seemed satisfied with the improvements made at Willowbrook Developmental Center during his tour of the institution yesterday. The governor last visited Willowbrook in December 1974. Four months later, when he became governor, he signed a consent decree which helped to bring about the improved conditions.

The decree also calls for the reduction in the number of retarded persons living at Willowbrook to 250 by 1981. Gov. Carey was especially pleased with the progress of residents who are participating in a vocational workshop program and the fact that they now are able to work.
