Group to Have Willowbrook Role

The state agreed yesterday to allow United Cerebral Palsy to operate five of the 26 dormitories at the Willowbrook Developmental Center. The dormitories house one fifth of the nearly 2,500 inmates at the Staten Island hospital.

The agreement, reached before Brooklyn Federal Judge John Bartels, requires the state and United Cerebral Palsy to enter a contract by July 1 under which the state would pay for the program and the organization would hire staff and administrative personnel.
