after dispute at intersection

A New Brighton man was stabbed four times early this morning by two men as he arrived at work in the Willowbrook Developmental Center, apparently after he had an argument with his assailants about two miles away.

Police said Garland Winfield, 25, was rushed by ambulance to St. Vincent's Medical Čenter, where his condition was being evaluated this morning for possi-

ble surgery.

The incident occurred about 6:30 a.m., when an argument developed between Winfield and the two other men at the intersection of Victory Blvd., Watcho-gue Rd. and Jewett Ave., Meiers Corners. Police said the two men, driving in a green Mustang, followed Winfield to work at Building 27 of the developmental center, where they got out and stabbed him twice in the chest and twice in the abdomen.

Winfield was conscious when rushed to the medical center, but his wounds were believed to be deep and it was believed surgery would be necessary.

Police said Winfield's attackers apparently jumped back in their auto and fled.
