Sea View cottages

Renovation of one of four buildings at Sea View Hospital and Home by United Cerebral Palsy of New York is expected to hegin later this month or early in June.

UCP received a license from the city Health and Hospitals Corp. in February to use A, B, C and D cottages on the Home side of Brielle Ave. to consolidate its school, which is housed now in the South Beach Psychiatric Center, and a sheltered Port Richmond workshop.

The four cottages, which had housed aged Sea View patients, were licensed to the agency for \$11,200 a year.

UCP representatives had said that the buildings needed renovation to allow safe access for its clients.
