CIVIL SERVICE: Civil Service Employees Association President Theodore Wenzl said that although the state's civil service system needs an overhaul, a bill introduced last week lacks the safeguards to insure state workers would be promoted objectively.

Wenzl said he opposed limitation of the so-called "rule of three" which requires one of the top three qualifiers on an exam to be selected for a job. Proposed legislation would replace the Civil Service Commission with a state director of personnel and a Civil Service Board.
