

Willowbrook takeover to be discussed

Members of Willowbrook's Civil Service Employees Association will hold a membership-only meeting Tuesday night to discuss possible actions intended to thwart the recent takeover of several buildings and their residents by the United Cerebral Palsy Foundation.

Felton King, chairman of the Association, described the union as "determined to use every means possible to get UCP out of Willowbrook."

UCP assumed control of seven of the complex's buildings with 640 residents Thursday amidst union protest and charges of incompetence by the CSEA.

King claimed a sickout initiated Thursday by CSEA employees was continuing, but Elin Howe, the acting administrator of the institution said that "absenteeism was consistent with what we normally experience on weekends" and that no sickout was apparent.
