Board to review 40 residential sites for disabled

Community Board 3 will sponsor a hearing Monday at 7:30 p.m. in Totten Intermediate School, Yetman and Academy Aves., Tottenville, to review sites under consideration as residential facilities for the developmentally disabled now residing in the Staten Island Developmental Center.

Although 40 sites are being reviewed, 16 sites will be chosen by the board and only 8 sites will finally be approved for the South Shore area by the state Department of Mental Hygiene.

While some of the proposed sites have only been

identified by the board according to the community and the tax block number of the site, the exact location of each site can be obtained by checking maps available at the board office in the Princes Bay Trade Mart, 100 Johnston Terr., Monday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Eleven sites in Tottenville are under consideration and eight of those sites have been identified by street address.

Those sites are located at 127 Main St., 6939 Amboy Rd., 204 Fisher Ave., 57 Bentley Ave., 106 Patton St., 147 Wood Ave., 5414 Arthur Kill Rd. and 750 Page Ave.

Eight proposed sites are located in the Annadale-Eltingville area and only two of those have been identified according to street address. Those sites are at 161 Bathgate St., Eltingville, and 24 Fabian St., Annadale.

Other sites listed according to address are at 410 Arthur Kill Rd., Great Kills; 6 Ainsworth Ave., Great Kills; 384 Mill Rd., New Dorp; 3024 Amboy Rd., Oakwood; 50 Dalton Ave., New Dorp; 51 Wilbur St., Princes Bay; 280 Ridgewood Ave., Eltingville, and the Tysens Lane Apartments, New Dorp.

Four lots are located in Great Kills; two in Huguenot; one site each in Princes Bay, Richmond Valley, Charleston, Arden Heights and Pleasant Plains, and three in Oakwood.
