Five sites designated as potential group homes for the retarded will be the focus of a public hearing by Community Board 2 on Wednesday at 8 p.m. in the nurses residence at Seaview Hospital and Home, 460 Brielle Ave.

Community Board 1 will hold a public hearing on Wednesday on a proposal by PrProctor & Gamble to put a conveyor belt over Western Ave., Mariners Harbor, The meeting is in St. Clement's-St. Michael's R.C. Church, also Mariners Harbor.
