

Island man reappointed to board

Matteo (Mike) Lumetta of Retford Ave., Eltingville, has been reappointed by Gov. Carey to a three-year term on the board of visitors of the Staten Island Developmental Center, Willowbrook.

The board of visitors is made up of parents and relatives of patients and former patients in state institutions, or persons who are knowledgeable about the care of the mentally retarded and developmenta-

lly disabled. Members act as liaisons between the state and the facilities.

Lumetta, who is the parent of a son with Downs syndrome, was first appointed to the board in 1980 to fill a term vacated by Robert Connelly, husband of Assemblywoman Elizabeth Connelly.

Lumetta is a commissioner of the Board of Elections. His unsalaried term on the board of visitors expires Dec. 31, 1985.
