Ailing man missing from Willowbrook

A physically and mentally impaired man has been missing from the Staten Island Developmental Center since last Friday, according to spokesmen for the center.

The man, Enrico Raia, 56, disappeared from the Willowbrook complex at 9:50 a.m. June 18. He is described by officials at the center as being severely retarded.

Along with his mental deficiencies, Raia, has a heart condition that requires constant monitoring and may develop into a sudden heart attack or stroke. He also requires medication for this condition.

Raia is 5 feet, 4 inches tall and weighs 125 pounds. His complexion is described as fair, while his hair is gray. He has no teeth and has recent scratches on both of his temples and cheeks.

According to developmental center officials, his medical problems may make him appear to be intoxicated.

He was last seen wearing black and white check pants with a blue Special Olympic T-shirt.
