

SIDC worker arraigned on drug charges

Alvin Evans, one of 12 workers arrested last month in a crack-down on alleged drug trafficking at the Staten Island Developmental Center, Willowbrook, was arraigned yesterday on two indictments, one of which had been previously sealed.

The latest indictment against Evans, 32, of 141 Park Hill Ave., Clifton, charged him with selling cocaine on two occasions, Feb. 22 and 28, at the center. An earlier indictment accused him of selling cocaine April 12, also at the center.

Supreme Court Justice Norman J. Felig permitted the defendant to remain free without bail until his next court appearance, Aug. 10. Innocent pleas were entered on Evans' behalf.

Other defendants who had been indicted in the same investigation also were arraigned yesterday.
