# *Mother jailed after heroin conviction*

A 31-year-old Clifton mother is serving a prison term of 4½ to nine years on her conviction by a jury of selling heroin at the Staten Island Developmental Center, Willowbrook.

The woman, Helen Chavis of 60 Park Hill Ave., was found guilty in February of selling the drug to a police undercover agent on Feb. 9, 1983, at the center, where she was then employed.
