

Hunt resumes for girl on S.I.

The search for Jennifer Schweiger, 12, missing since July 9, resumed yesterday as police and civilian volunteers combed Willowbrook Park in Staten Island for a third day.

The family and neighbors of the missing girl, civic groups and missing-children organizations joined in the search, which extended to the 382-acre Staten Island Development Center grounds adjacent to the park.

The area is not far from the youngster's home in Westerleigh.

"They've pretty much blanketed the area in previous searches but they want to check again to be sure they didn't leave anything out," said police Sgt. Raymond O'Donnell.

The girl, who suffers from Down's syndrome, was last seen walking near home with a man who appeared to be a vagrant, police said.
