Road, Richmond, are being built with a \$13 million, 30-year loan from the Industrial Development Agency of New York City. The new buildings will mean the nonprofit agency can move out of

three leased buildings located in Ocean Breeze, Tompkinsville and Great Kills.

The Travis center will be home to the Vocational Training Center, including the agency's Sheltered Workshop, which provides jobs for people with limited abilities, and the Day Treatment Center, an educational program for people with severe disabilities. The Richmond facility will house the CRDD pre-school, the Joan P. Hodum Early Learning Center.
