

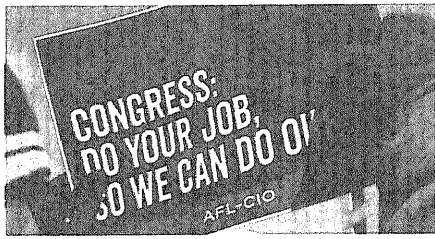

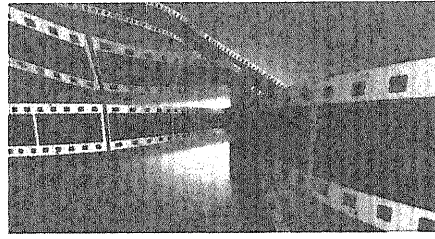

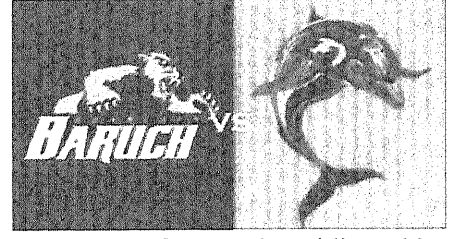

The New Student Activity Fee Proposal: Why It Matters

"It's a Bandaid, Not Permanent"

Before issuing the proposal for the reallocation of the Student Activity Fee, the Finance Committee of Student Government wanted a better understanding of how each operation works.

A team comprised of four Student Government members and two students set out with purpose to receive information about each earmarking groups' expenses and line items.

Ultimately, the team wanted to assess which groups

can take a hit for reallocation of the fee, and which cannot afford to lose any more and face a future deficit.

Once the committee gathered much of their needed information, they put all of the groups' budgets into a master head sheet and examined each budget individually.

At a recent Student Government meeting, there was an executive call that asked for people to be dismissed so the board could discuss the fee. As the approval occurred with several participants unaware, it should be noted how this proposal will affect everyone.

According to the team, they wanted to project how each group will stand next year, since some groups will not spend the entirety of their budget. So, they analyzed which earmarking groups should experience increases and cuts in order to redistribute the Student Activity Fee and also determine how to create a new line for a Commencement Fee.

The need for a Commencement Fee has been discussed because the commencement expenses have burdened CSI Association's budget.

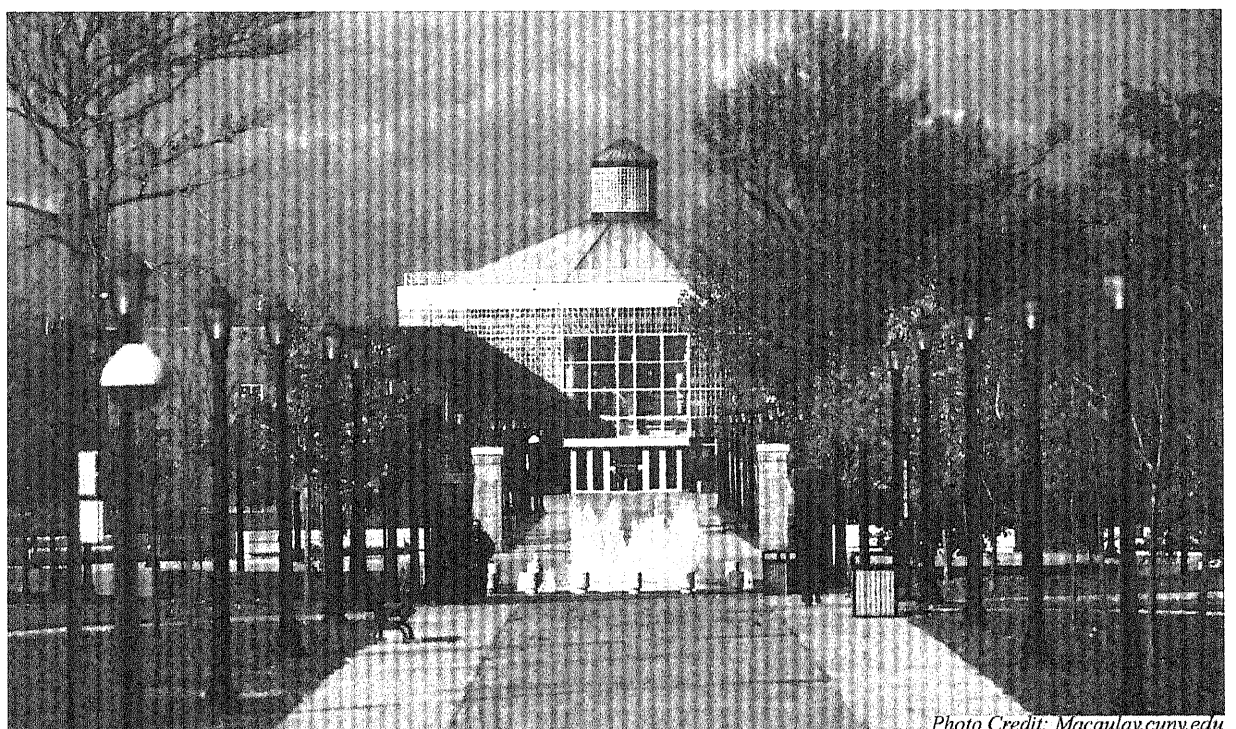
Only after you do a little digging and push to the side the usual givings, do you find what the college really has to offer.

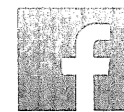

The Longest Government Shutdown in U.S. History Continues

President Trump Refuses Negotiations For His Wall

Since December 22, 2018, the U.S. government has been on its continued streak as having been in the longest government shutdown in the country's history. President Trump declared a partial government shutdown after failed talks with Congress to support funding for a barrier along the southern border, of which he claims will keep out illegal immigrants and other unwanted persons from crossing into the United States.

This marks the second government shutdown to have taken place during Trump's presidency.

Considering how long the duration of the government shutdown has been thus far, legitimate concerns have been expressed as to how much of a negative impact it could have on the U.S. economy and other federal government affairs.

As a result of the shutdown, several government institutions have been halted and with that, so have incoming paychecks for government workers. Although certain institutions like the U.S. Postal Service and law firm agencies continue to function as usual, others like NASA and Homeland Security have been at the forefront of the distressing effects of the shutdown.

So far, the most widely publicized backlash against Trump's shutdown has been from TSA (Transportation Security Authority) workers around the country. Workers have taken to the streets to protest and have begun to call out of work sick as they search for other, more reliable sources

of income someplace else.

"We have a very stressful job as it is and for people to be worried about how they're going to pay their babysitter and pay their mortgage and their bills, it's just not something that is needed in our position," said Ben Struck, an aviation safety inspector to PIX11 news.

With less staff, travel time has increased

declare a "national emergency" if his demands for border funding are not met. However, Trump has decided for the meantime to only use that declaration as a last resort.

Nearly three weeks in, and neither side has been able to reach an agreement on the issue.

On January 8th, President Trump ap-

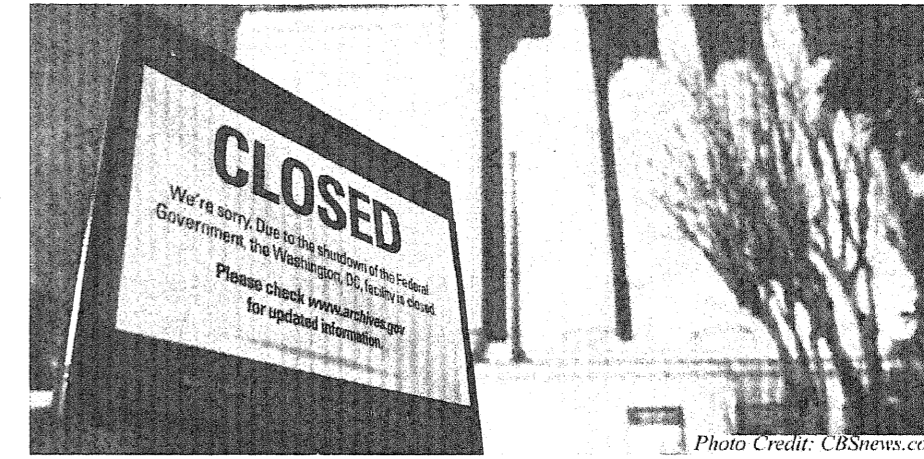

pealed to the American people on television regarding the debate. Shortly after, House Speaker Nancy Pelosi and Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer spoke on behalf of the Democrats.

Finding a viable source of income has been the hardest issue to tackle. The Trump administration has suggested using untouched natural disaster and emergency fund money as a possible source of budget for the construction of the wall.

President Trump has threatened to

According to CNN, "Congress appropriated \$14 billion in supplemental funds to repair infrastructure in areas of the country hardest hit by disasters. In anticipation of a national emergency declaration, the official tells CNN that the Pentagon was asked to provide lists of unspent funds including those earmarked for civil works projects that are part of disaster recovery in Puerto Rico, Texas, California, Florida, and elsewhere."

People such as Senator John Cornyn, a Republican from Texas, is opposed to using these disaster funds to undertake such a project.

Cornyn stated, "So the President is now talking to his lawyers about whether he would have the authority to issue a national emergency and reprogram money that's been allocated for other purposes, but I will tell you that I will oppose any reprogramming of Harvey disaster funds. We worked very hard to make sure that the victims of Hurricane Harvey — their concerns are addressed and Texas is able to rebuild. And I think we are all together on that."

Those opposed to wall funding also believe that the current southern border does not pose a serious threat to the country like the President says it does. Other, more realistic policies can improve border security.

The shutdown is expected to last throughout January until Trump and Congress can reach an agreement and end the deadlock.

A Breakdown of Brexit: For Better or For Worse?

Theresa May's Leadership is Challenged, But The Motion For Brexit Continues

An organization of 28 states and 513 million people, the European Union (EU) is a major force in setting economic standards throughout Western Europe. The EU was initially created in the 1950s to avoid conflict after World War II. Since then, it has grown into a massive single market that allows for the free movement of goods and people between member states.

One of those member states, the United Kingdom, is set to leave the EU next year. That is, if all goes to plan.

On December 11th, the UK Parliament was scheduled to vote on Prime Minister Theresa May's departure plan. May delayed the vote and traveled to Brussels to make amendments to her draft.

The future of May's leadership came to

a halt on Wednesday morning, when members of the Conservative Party called for a vote of no confidence.

The motion meant that 15% of the majority party in the House of Commons lost faith in their leader. 48 members of May's Conservative Party called her leadership into question.

The vote occurred later that night among Conservative MPs. With 200 Conservatives voting for her and 117 voting against her, reported by Aljazeera, May will remain Prime Minister.

The parliament vote on May's draft is expected to occur before January 21st.

In June of 2016, the UK held a referendum on whether to stay or leave the EU. 52% of voters chose to leave.

Member states may leave the EU

through a process described in Article 50 of the Lisbon Treaty. Prime Minister May began this withdrawal process on March 29th, 2017.

The UK will leave the EU on March 29th, 2019. Within this two-year period, Britain and the union have created a plan of action. This includes the country's withdrawal agreement and future relationship with the EU.

Britain's departure, notably referred to as Brexit, was years in the making. Those that want to leave believe the EU is dysfunctional and fails to address growing unemployment and immigration. There is also widespread distrust in multinational organizations, especially those created after World War II, according to Forbes.

Opponents of Brexit are concerned about maintaining amicable relations with major states of the EU and are unsure about the country's future economy after March. After the 2016 referendum, real wages in the UK have grown less than the rate of inflation.

Major concerns as Brexit approaches are Ireland and Northern Ireland relations. May's plan sets out a "backstop" to prevent a harsh border between Ireland and Northern Ireland during the post-Brexit period, noted in Aljazeera.

If the House of Commons agrees with May's draft, it will be introduced to all of parliament as a bill. It must be signed into law by March 29th.

May has a slim majority in the House

of Commons- if the plan is not approved, members of parliament must agree on another way to proceed. This may hinder the withdrawal in March, and leave the future of UK-EU relations in limbo.

Lawmakers may disagree on the plan altogether and call for another referendum just months before departure.

The official UK Parliament website details Britain's contribution to the EU budget. In 2017, Britain contributed around €13 billion, about 17% of the EU budget. The country received €4.1 billion back from the union, making a net contribution of €8.9 billion.

Supporters of Brexit believe the EU no longer serves a valuable purpose for Britain. The country contributes a significant percentage to the budget, but does not get much in return.

The UK will not have to contribute to the EU as much as it did before, or depend on approval from the EU council if Brexit prevails. Funding can go towards other development in the country instead.

Brexit is a chance for Britain to reach its full economic potential and become a leader in modern trade, free from the rules of the EU.

If Britain ever wants to rejoin the European Union, it must go through the same process that all prospective states go through. For now, it is on track to being the first member state to depart, and Prime Minister May will surely face criticism along the way.

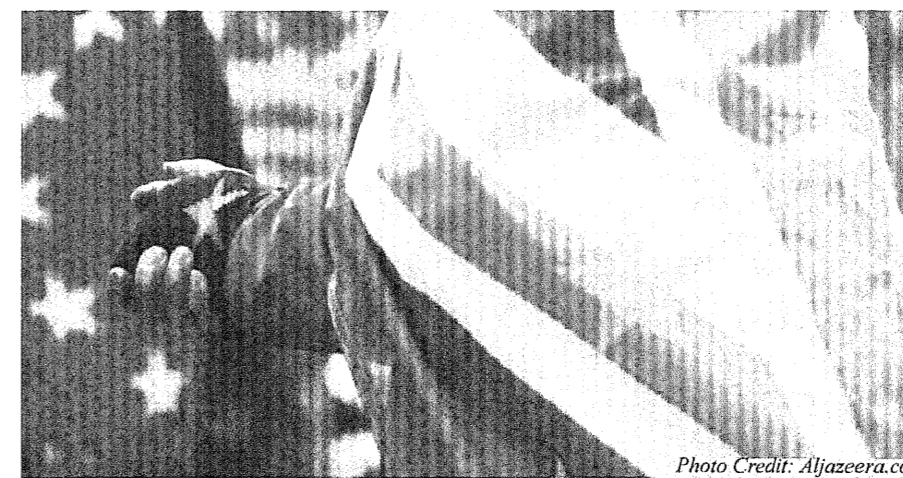

As proposed, there would now be a separate \$50,000 budget for Commencement each year. While this lifts a heavy weight off of the CSI Associations' shoulders, it may affect a few groups who can afford to spare part of their money.

Moving with their plan, the committee sought out groups that had extraneous expenses that might not be relevant for all students. This is important because regardless if a student is full time or part time, they contribute to this Student Activity Fee.

For instance, Athletics had expenses of around \$18,000 for recruiting future athletes. This expense does not apply to the current students who pay to attend CSI. In addition, the part-time students on campus are unable to even be part of a sports team.

With a decent number of students who are unable to participate, the roughly \$17 that these part time and summer students are paying toward the fee could be reallocated for things that they can actually make use of.

Along with this idea of paying for things that you are not able to participate in, summer semester students are currently paying for activities that are often not offered in the summer.

Typically, clubs, publications, intramurals, and sports are not having meet-

ings or practices during the summertime.

So with the new reallocation, full time students would be contributing \$27, part time students would be contributing \$15, and \$14.25 from summer students.

Along with Athletics, WSIA Radio Station would be facing a loss from the reallocation. This was determined because their prior year expenditures did not justify the current fee amount.

Publications will also potentially be taking a hit for the similar reasoning. However, with emerging publications such as "Queer-Zine", "Brainbow", and "All Ways A Woman", this may cause a future shortage of money to allocate for their usage- just about \$30,000 to split between the three new groups.

Moreover, Student Government is modifying their own expenses, specifically by decreasing the amount of stipends that are issued to their leaders. By doing this, Student Government hopes to set a precedent to value the needs of the college first.

Another group that is having their part of the fee modified is Transportation. Specifically, Transportation used to be funded by college support. In recent years, Transportation expenses have been carried by the Student Activity Fee.

In fact, a majority of CSI's population commutes by car, not transit.

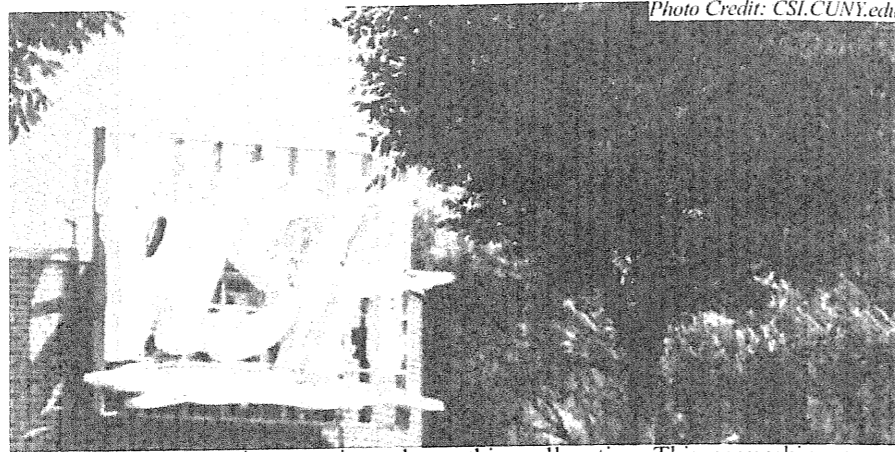

With Transportation services being cut either way, Student Government members felt that reducing their revenue would not change the services offered to students currently.

While some groups may face the brunt of the blow, other groups might benefit from this reallocation. According to projections, intramurals were going to be negative. With the current evaluation of each budget, there would be an increase in the money allocated to intramurals.

Health and Wellness, an important service for students on campus, is partially funded by the Student Activity Fee. In order to keep this program sustained for the students, the proposal initiates an increase to revenue to match the current operating expenses.

Childcare will also be benefiting from

this reallocation. This earmarking group receives most of their funding from grants, many of which are not guaranteed. With increases from the Student Activity Fee, childcare services will continue to be offered to students who need it.

However, the same argument could perhaps be applied to figure out whether students who do not utilize the childcare center at all should contribute to this program.

While this all sounds logical to give money where it is needed, this reallocation serves as only a bandaid.

In order to fix this issue in the future without much redistribution of money, students are encouraged to come vote in the Spring elections, about 10% of the student body is needed to help these groups that are at risk at CSI.

Featured on TV shows, movies and magazines, this will surely be a hit for all those who go.

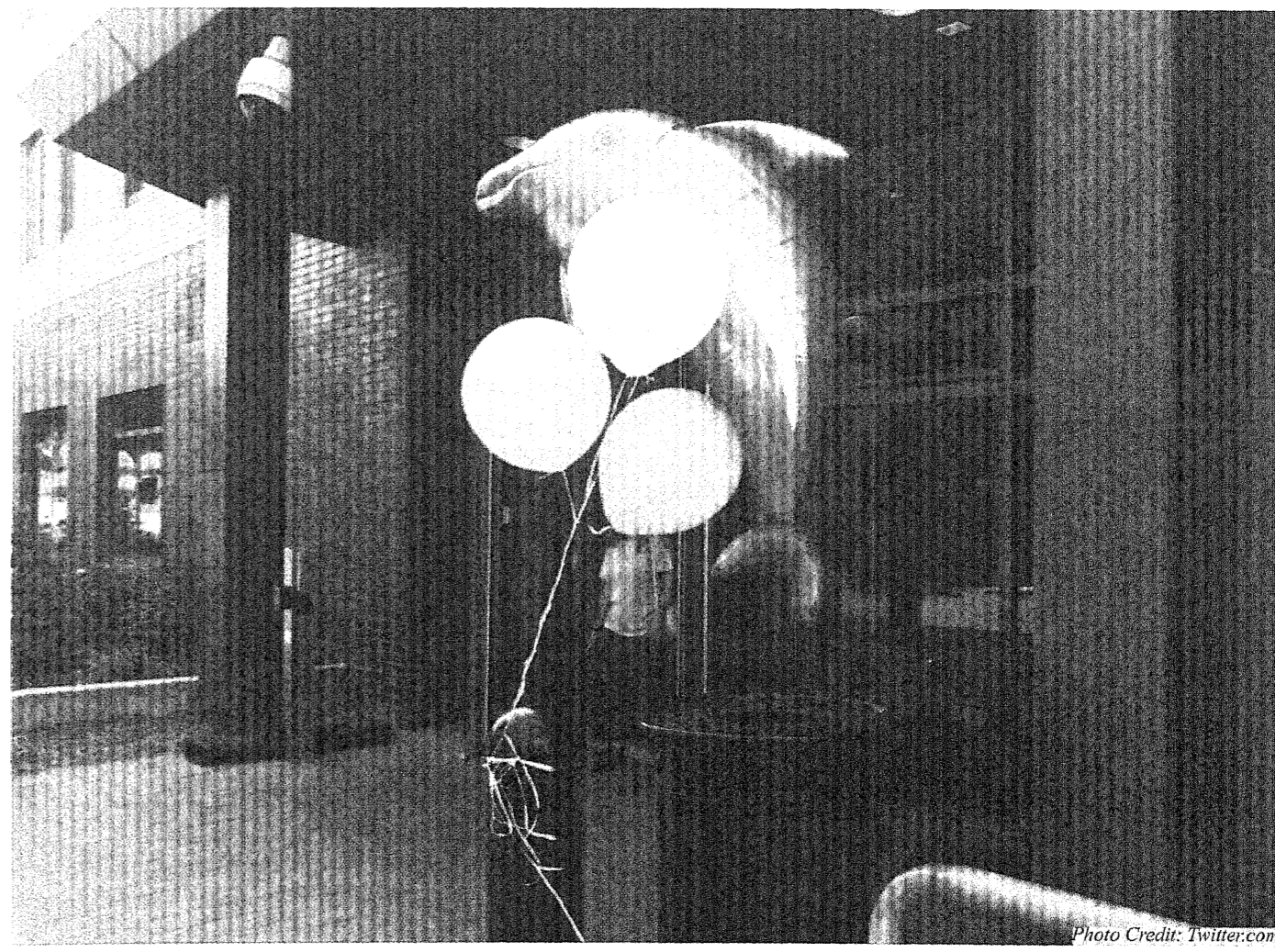

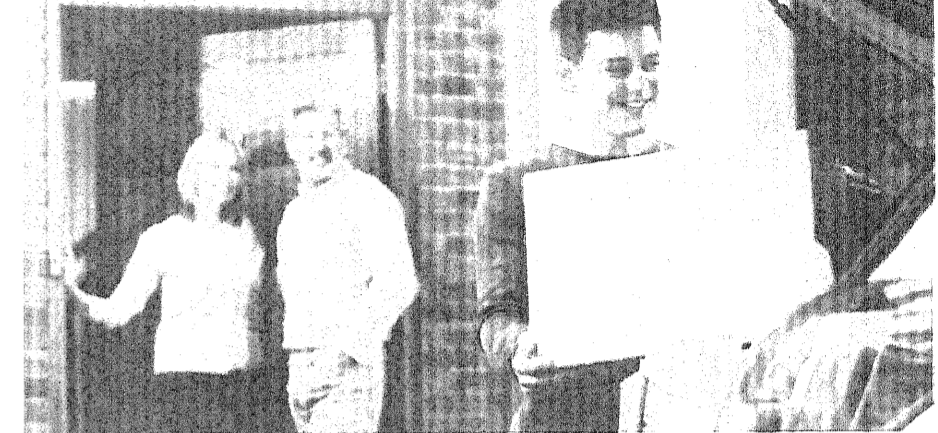

The Popular "Wrapped" Feature Returns with a Breakdown of Your Listening History

The end of the year is an exciting time. With Christmas and New Year's just around the corner, many of us enjoy looking back on the memories we made over the past 12 months.

For music lovers, it's easier than ever to reflect on your past year in music. That is, of course, if you're a member of the popular streaming app Spotify.

The music service rolled out its beloved "Wrapped" feature in early December. Spotify Wrapped is a microsite, meaning it is an extension of its home website. It analyzes your listening data from the past year and organizes it into a visually-appealing highlight reel.

It contains several pages of highlights. The "Firsts" page tells you the first song you listened to in 2018, and the next quizzes you on the amount of time you spent listening to music this past year.

Spotify Wrapped will not only tell you your favorite artist of the year, but it shows how many hours you spent listening to them.

You will also get a list of your top five artists, songs, and genres. Spotify takes their year-in-review a step further by creating a "Top 100" playlist just for you, filled with your top 100 songs.

The feature not only includes data, but an

easily-consumable presentation that makes viewers feel like they are having a conversation with Spotify. It makes comments on listening habits, though they are not individualized. For example, it will note that your music taste is unique if you listen to an unpopular genre.

It also includes the oldest song you listened to.

Spotify also picks songs from artists and genres you haven't listened to and presents them in a personal 50-song playlist called "Tastebreakers," promising that you'll love it. It claims to pick these songs based on the ones you love.

One of the most popular pages from Spotify Wrapped feeds off the social media astrology craze. If applicable, it will tell you the most common sign from your past year. After viewing your interactive Wrapped slideshow, you are presented the option to share your stats on a scorecard across a variety of social media apps, from Instagram to Facebook.

Spotify Premium users are offered a special opportunity to share their 2018 Wrapped on a Times Square Billboard, given they provide their email address, name, and a photo of themselves.

In addition to your own personal statistics, Spotify also released general listening habits from 2018.

The top male artist of 2018 based on number of streams was Drake, and the top female artist was Ariana Grande. Drake's song "God's Plan" was the most streamed song of the year.

According to Spotify, 2018's "Rising Genre" is emo rap. However, the genre did not make it to the Most Streamed category. Harry Styles's "Girl Crush" was the most streamed Spotify Single, and the most streamed Spotify Playlist was "Today's Top Hits."

The top three breakout artists, from third to first, were King Princess, Normani, and Juice WRLD.

Spotify also included the top three "Throwback Songs" of the year. Based on their strong presence in social media in 2018,

it's no surprise that Toto's "Africa" and A-ha's "Take On Me" were first and second, respectively. "Billie Jean" by Michael Jackson came third.

Based on stream frequency of mood-based playlists, Spotify also created a graph to show "2018 Moods by Age." According to the graph, people in their teens and 20s are "lit," people in their 30s are "happy," and people in their 40s and above are "relaxed."

If you aren't a Spotify member, now might be the time to join. The streaming service is unique for its combination of music and social media, you can follow your friends, listen to their playlists, and enjoy live updates of their musical adventures.

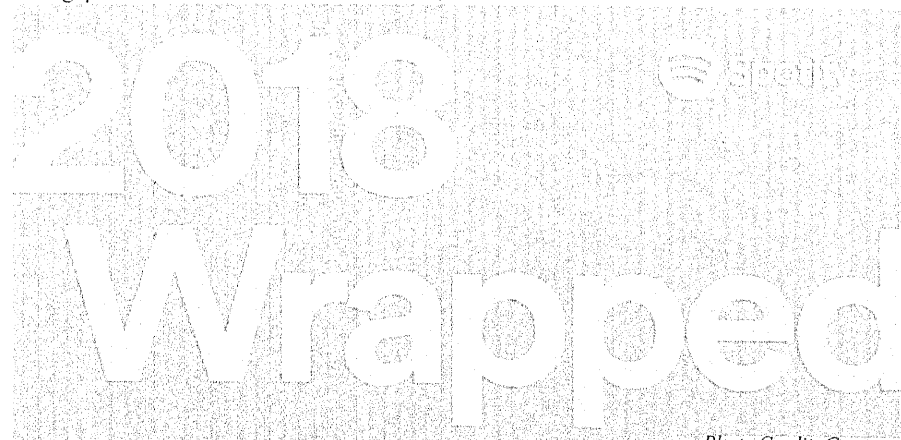

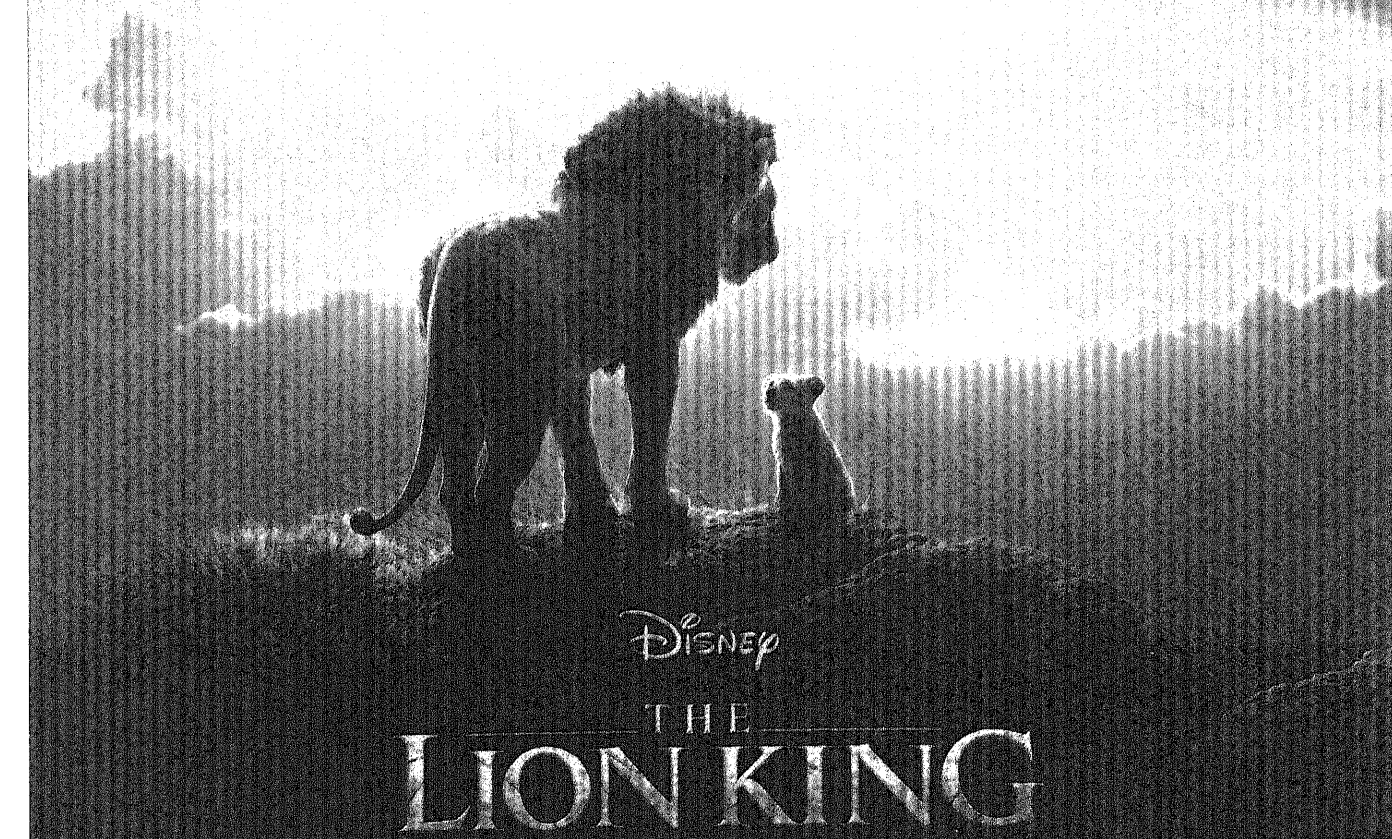

Fortnite: Same Story, Different Day

A Relatively Tolerable Game with an Utterly Unbearable Phenomenon.

Although the concept is not new in the slightest, Battle Royale is unquestionably the biggest gaming phenomenon this past decade. Many games have achieved a meaningful form of notability or attention in this genre, but none have reached the levels of mainstream success that Fortnite has.

The reason for the unprecedented success of Fortnite arguably has less to do with the gameplay itself and more to do with its accessibility. At its core, the game is just like every other Battle Royale game where you look for players to defeat across an expansive map.

Apart from the building mechanics, Fortnite is incredibly standard as a game, which makes it something that's easy to pick up and play. Fortnite excelled against all competitors because it was, and still is an early access game, making it free to play.

The game is also more vibrant and cartoonish than other battle royale games, which helps in marketing the game to a wide audience. After all, parents won't have to worry about any disturbing or ma-

ture content if the game is so light-hearted on the surface.

With all of the positive attention and exposure Fortnite has received, it makes sense that the game would also receive a good amount of negative attention. With all due respect to Fortnite, it's relatively harmless as a game in spite of its repetitive qualities.

The game seems relatively fun to play; it is well programmed with few game breaking glitches or exploits, but it suffers from the issue of dead time between fights, which has more to do with the genre itself.

The problems with Fortnite only become apparent, blatantly at that, when looking at the community and culture surrounding the game itself. Arguably, Fortnite is one of the worst cultural phenomenon to have occurred in recent memory.

Because Fortnite is so widespread and popular among gamers, it can be marketed with ease and turned into a cash cow of sorts. This can have a negative on both the property itself and the market surrounding the property.

By making something as consumer friendly and marketable as possible, de-

velopers run the risk of dumping down the idea too much, resulting in an overly simplistic or inoffensive product that only exists to appease a group of people.

The effect it can have on the surrounding market is that every other property tries copying the most popular one of the bunch, thus oversaturation happens and games stick out less.

This has happened as early as the 90's with the mascot platformer craze and as recently when first-person shooters attempted to replicate Call of Duty, which has ironically copied Fortnite with its Blackout game mode.

This attention has also drawn a more casual crowd of gamers towards the game, and more often than not these more casual gamers are focused almost entirely on popular IPs. It trivializes other games and genres, which is reinforced further when companies only promote these popular games.

It's a vicious cycle of sorts that only assists in making it more difficult for smaller and more unique properties to receive attention. The game isn't going to appeal to everybody no matter what happens, and giving it all of this attention isn't going to convince people to play or like the game either.

However, the biggest problem with Fortnite and why it's reached its current status is the community and fandom. When a franchise becomes mainstream, it usually attracts a sizable number of reasonable fans as well as a sizable number of more unruly fans.

Fortnite's fan base isn't entirely new when it comes to its flaws, but it's arguably even worse than some of the most notorious internet fan bases out there. The

high number of children in the community doesn't help these matters, and it's mostly because of their naivete.

Because kids are incredibly naive, producers and other such people will try taking advantage of their trusting nature. Some of the ways this has already happened include Youtubers making mindless and/or click-bait-esque videos of Fortnite, people exaggerating events that happen in the game or even by inserting Fortnite into every situation possible for a cheap thrill.

This is most egregious with the Fortnite dances, which are ridiculously stupid and embarrassing. To most people, these dances would be considered obnoxious, but to kids they might seem hilarious or endearing because they are presented as such.

Thus kids could try replicating this kind of behavior, which makes for an annoying and unfavorable community. There are even older people in the community. Twitch streamer Ninja falls into this trap, be it due to his over the top reactions or poor sportsmanship, which was at its worst when he falsely reported somebody for "stream sniping."

Fortnite has a very toxic and unfavorable community, but ultimately it isn't anything new. Communities before Fortnite have come and gone before, and it is only this bad due to the levels of success the game has reached.

Fortnite as a game is not entirely noteworthy, but it has more than built up a reputation for itself because of its cultural status. Given developer Epic Game's lack of attention towards Fortnite's "Save the World" mode, which might very well fade into obscurity and be nothing more than a footnote in gaming, and one that shouldn't be copied at that.

The Risks of Using Cat Fishing Dating Services

All That Glitters is Not Gold

give money or send intimate photos - or are trying to gather enough information to commit fraud identity."

"Block anyone suspicious. Do a background check - google a potential date if you have enough details. You can also use searches created for potential dates as well, thanks to the increase of online dating apps."

"Look for red flags, such as spelling mistakes and bad grammar on a profile when someone has stated they're college or university educated. One of the biggest indicators of catfishing is when a person makes excuses to not meet up, won't do a video call, and even avoids all conversation about when to meet up. So, if they're putting off a face-to-face date it could mean they have something to hide."

"If a profile photo looks like a Hollywood movie star or model and appears too good to be true, use Google images to check the profile photo. If it comes up on another site that makes you feel suspicious, or it's out rightly a magazine cover model, you are being potentially cat-

fished. You can also use Catfish reverse image search apps."

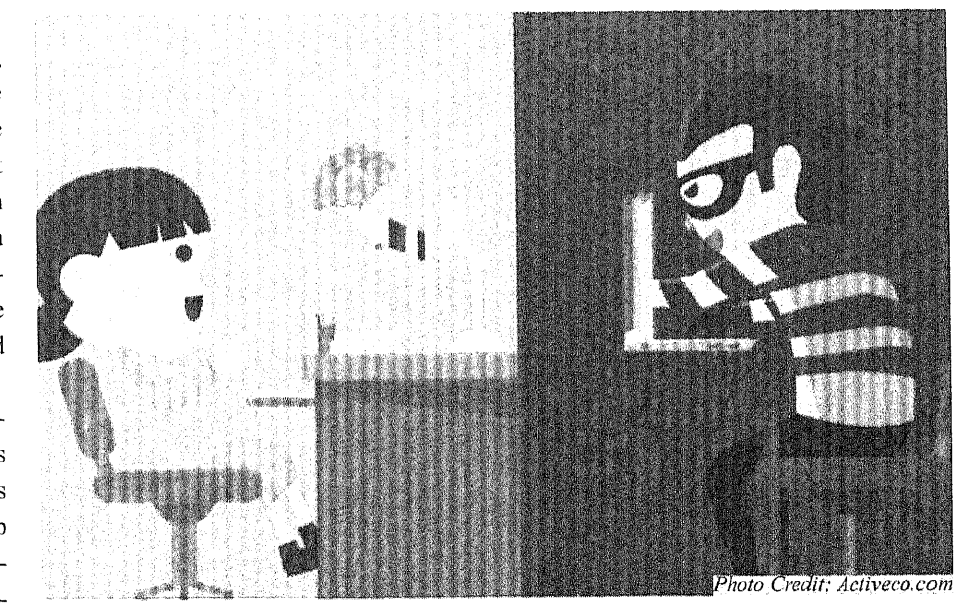
Ferrari gives us warning signs to look for while searching for love on these dating websites. She fills us in on all potential harm that a catfish could do to us without knowing.

Ferrari also mentions in her article that there is something else that we need to watch out for when exploring the dating websites online or the dating apps. Have you ever heard of kitten fishing? Ms. Ferrari states that this is, "a much lighter version of catfishing, it's when someone embellishes or improves their

profile to make themselves more appealing online - such as using a photo from ten years ago, adjusting their age, or lying about their education or profession."

In other words, while looking for love just be careful and mindful of who you pick and choose to become friendly with. Pay close attention to all the warning signs that were mentioned previously in the article. If you do, you will save yourself a lot of time and energy wasted on a person who might be a potential predator.

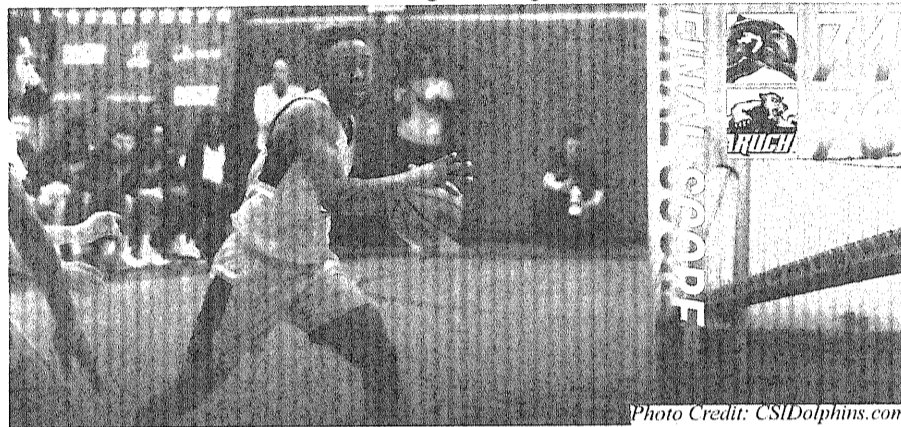

CSI closed the season with a 17-10 record and had their third consecutive CUNYAC Championship taken from them. Latunji contributed 11 points and 11 rebounds while Martin performed with 13 points and 6 rebounds. MVP Andre Harris led Baruch with 29 points.

Boateng's jumper from the elbow with 0.2 seconds left was the game winner and the shot heard around the Burroughs. The Bearcats have now advanced to the NCAA Division III National Championship Tournament. "Even though the season ended we were still getting better", says coach Tibbs who draws attention to the fact that the team is continuing to move forward.

Destime adds to this when he states, "You just got to keep your head up and keep moving forward. It was a really tough loss but we fought our hardest. Stephen Flagg, one of our biggest pieces, is graduating but he is the only senior so everybody else is scheduled to return back. The off season is going to be big for all of us."

Moving forward, the College of Staten Island looks forward to seeing what this team will do with all of their talent and heart. The highest levels of both were brought to light during this face off and sometimes the buzzer beater falls the other way.

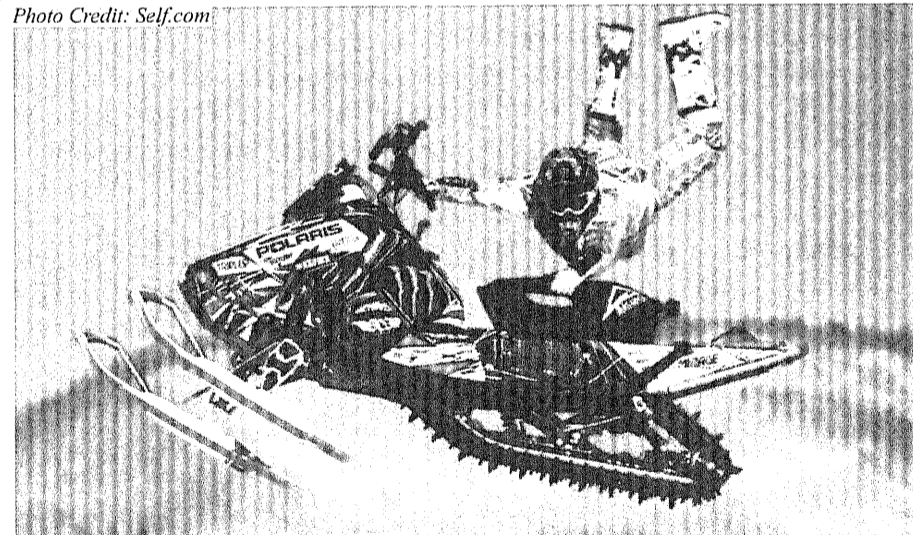
