As a whole, the Class of 1962 discovered and furthered career goals while attending Staten Island Community College.



As might be expected, marriage and a family are part of the future plans of the majority of the class.


A large percentage of the Class of 1962 is planning to continue its education toward bachelors' and professional degrees, leading ultimately to still higher degrees.

In response to a poll of the class, comments clearly revealed a persistent awareness of responsibility to the community.






