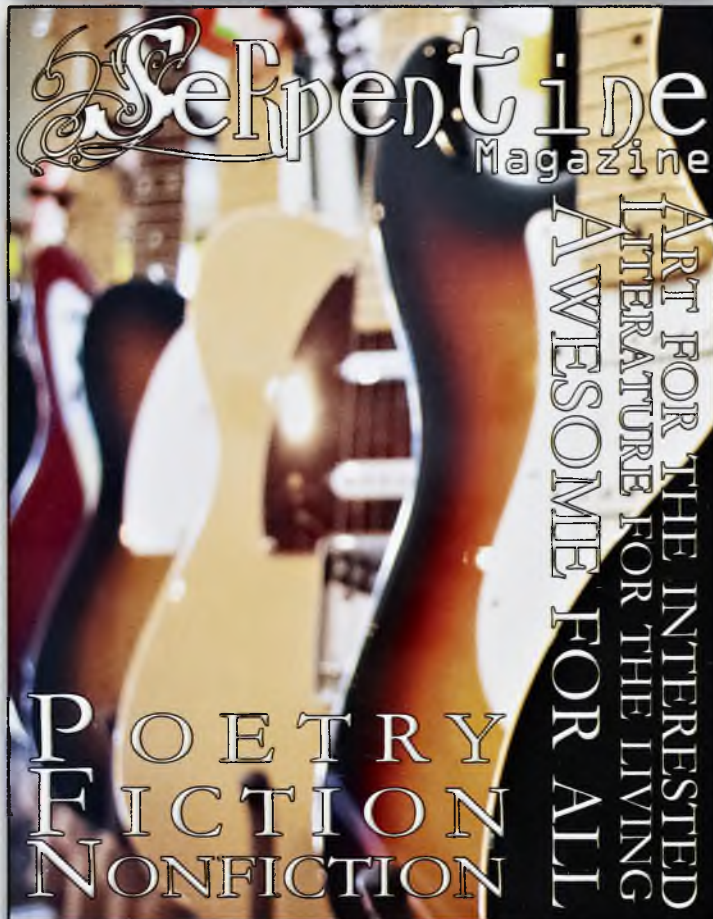
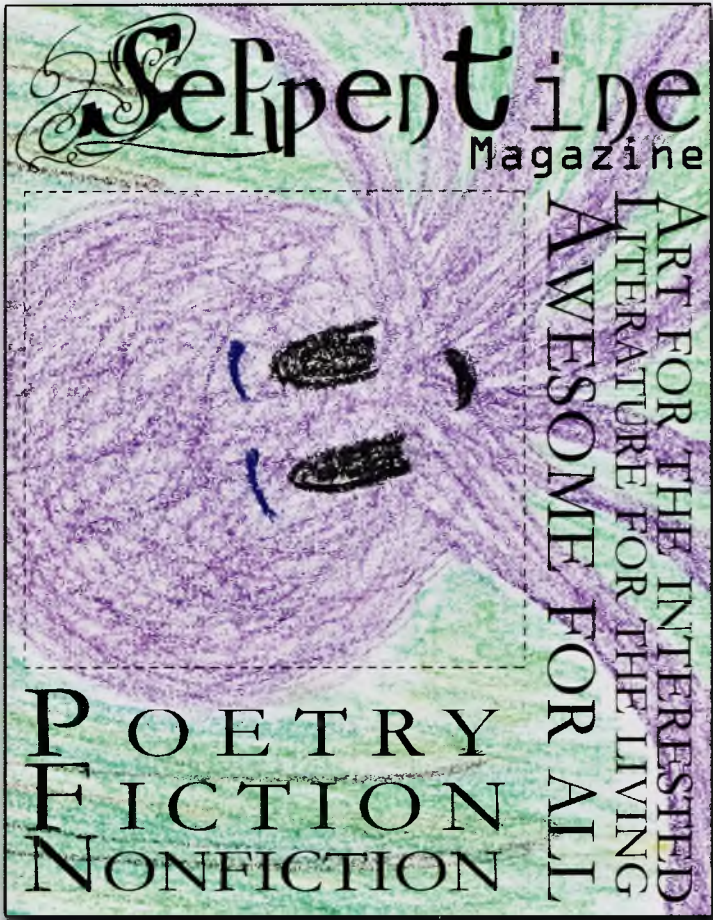

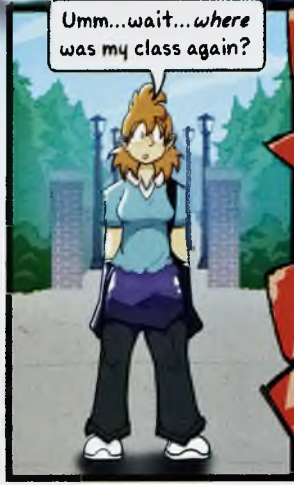

for yesterday envies today.

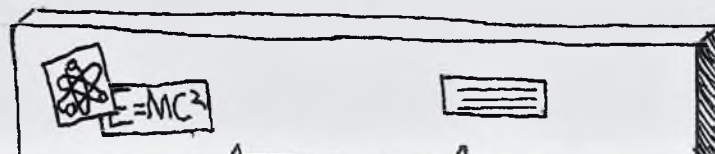
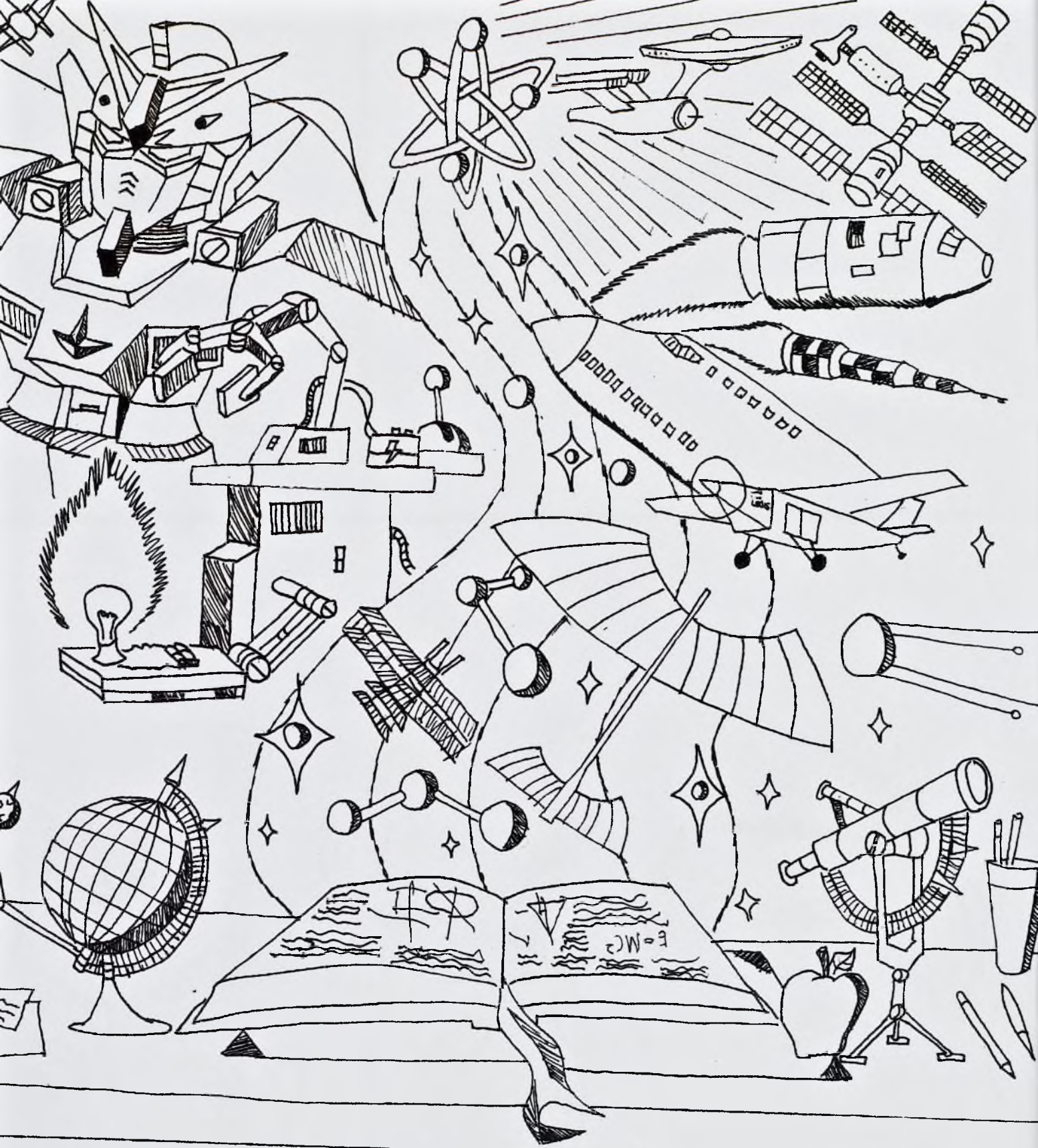
