





COMIC RELIEF

PART OF HIS CHARACTER.

THERE ARE TWO WAYS TO LOOK AT CHARACTERS. THE FIRST IS THAT THEY ARE NOTHING MORE THAN A DEVICE OF THE PLOT, OR A MESSENGER OF A JOKE. THE OTHER WAY TO LOOK AT THEM IS TO SAY THAT THEY ARE DEEP, IMPORTANT, AND OFTEN TIMES GREATER THAN THE PLOT. HOWEVER, SINCE WE'RE MAKING A COMIC STRIP AND NOT HAMLET, I'M GOING TO LEAN MORE TOWARDS THE FIRST LINE OF THOUGHT IN THIS CASE.

Your characters do not need to be complex, nor do they need to be abundant. Some of the greatest strips ever have only had one character, or very simple characters. For example, Cyanide and Happiness (I feel one of the funniest comics on the web) uses stick figures. For this strip, my character is going to be a rock.

My rock is a simple one: an ugly shape drawn with the paint brush tool, filled with brown, black lines, and then the blur filter until \mathbf{I} couldn't tell they were lines anymore. Not even a full paragraph for character creation.

IN CONTRAST, A COMPLEX CHARACTER MIGHT TAKE SEVERAL LAYERS OF COLORING AND DETAIL, IF YOU SO WISH TO INVEST THAT MUCH TIME INTO IT. YOU MIGHT HAVE TO PLAY AROUND WITH IDEAS FOR A WHILE UNTIL YOU FIND A CHARACTER YOU'RE HAPPY WITH (FIG. 1). DON'T GET DISCOURAGED, GET CREATIVE. IT'S NOT JUST CHEESEY, IT'S GOOD ADVICE.

THEY NEVER SHUT UP.

THERE'S A FEW WAYS YOU CAN SHOW THAT A CHARACTER (OR ANYONE ELSE) IS TALKING. THE MOST NOTORIOUS OF THEM IS THE SPEECH BUBBLE, WHICH ALL READERS WILL KNOW OF, UNLESS THEY'VE BEEN LIVING IN SOME OBSCURE PLACE THAT DOESN'T HAVE THE CIVILITY TO HAVE COMICS. THERE ARE SEVERAL WAYS TO MAKE A SPEECH BUBBLE, THE EASIEST BEING TO SIMPLY USE THE CIRCLE SELECTION TOOL, HOLD SHIFT, AND USING THE POLYGONAL LASSO TOOL. NOW FILL THE WHOLE THING WITH WHITE AND STROKE IT IN BLACK (FIG. 2). TA-DA. I WON'T BOTHER SHOWING THE OTHER WAYS, SINCE WE'VE ALREADY GOT THE SPEECH BOX.


WHAT YOU HAVE YOUR CHARACTERS SAY AND DO IS JUST AS IMPORTANT AS WHAT THEY ARE AND HOW THEY LOOK (REALISTICALLY, MORE SO). I CAN'T MAKE YOU WRITE ANY BETTER OR WORSE THAN YOU ALREADY DO, AND IT WOULD BE A CRIME FOR ME TO EVEN BOTHER TRYING. I WILL, HOWEVER, SAY THAT YOUR AUDIENCE IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN YOUR CONTEXT. IF YOU KNOW WHAT PEOPLE LIKE, TRY TO STAY IN THE SAME LINE OF THOUGHT.


IF YOU'VE GROWN AN AUDIENCE THAT RELISHES DARK HUMOR, FOR EXAMPLE, SWITCHING SHARPLY TO A SCI-FI ROMANCE IS LIKELY TO HAVE YOU LOSE READERSHIP AND/OR BE STONED ON THE WAY TO THE BODEGA ON THE CORNER. IT'S HAPPENED IN THE PAST, DON'T LAUGH. ONCE YOU SET A PRECEDENT, IT'S BEST TO KEEP UP WITH THE SAME GENRE.

The Next most important things to keep in mind are spelling and grammar. If your readers can't understand what you've written, then it doesn't matter how clever, deep, or hilarious it is. You'll be branded as an illiterate fool, and ignored for the rest of your career. It's alright for hand drawn comics when you're 8-12, but after that it's inexcusable. Put it all down in Word and spell check it first, and re-read everything.

For the sake of this comic, we'll go with something simple. "Why did the chicken cross the road?" "...I wish I had friends." (Fig. 3)

ATTENTION ARTISTS! ORPHAN WORKS LEGISLATION WANTS TO TAKE YOUR RIGHTS

AWAY!

"That's a very lovely painting you have there. Is it registered with the government? No? That would look great on my advertisement billboard. I'll just be taking this from you now. You can try and prove it's yours. Oh, and by the way, you won't be receiving any money from this either."

Has this happened to you? I hope it hasn't. In a situation like this you have the right and choice to pursue any legal actions against someone who takes your creation and uses it without your permission for personal gain. With "Orphan Works" you'd be shit out of luck.

"Orphan Works" is being presented to Congress and is very close to becoming a law. You might be asking "Orphan? Like the children?" Well, not exactly, in fact, not at all. "Orphan Works" takes away all your rights in owning your artwork. This includes, but is not limited to, every sketch, painting, photo, sculpture, drawing, video, song and every other type of creative endeavor. Currently in the United States, copyright law allows artists ownership immediately after creation. Although it's not registered with copyright establishments, whoever created it, owns it. Someone wants to change that. What "Orphan Works" will do is force every artist to register their pieces of art with Copyright registries and will make you pay money to do so. This is to ensure you that your artwork will not become "orphaned" like a little lost child. In other words, if your work isn't registered than anyone is entitled to take it.

Not only does this force you to pay your hard earned money but gives complete strangers the right to take your art and use it in whichever way they choose. This is a very serious issue. This will greatly affect the careers of artists everywhere. Everything that was created within the past 34 years will become public domain. If you're thinking "Well, I'll just register my artwork and it will be safe." you're wrong. Registering your art doesn't make it safe. There is no guarantee that someone who wishes to steal your creation won't successfully prove your work is orphaned and then legally use it for free. You will not receive any recognition or money.

YOU WILL LOSE YOUR RIGHT TO MAKE MONEY FROM YOUR CREATIONS.


And your creations aren't even the end of it. What else could they possibly take? How about those photographs you have in your photo albums? Pictures taken of your personal lives stand at stake to "Orphan Works". Photographs of your children, your family, photographs from birthdays, vacations, all of them are at risk. That means unless you register them with Copyright anyone can take them and use them for magazines, newspapers, billboards, the possibilities are endless. With millions of people sharing photos online with free sites like Shutterfly or Snapfish, there is a huge opportunity for anyone to take them, legally.

So why would anyone allow this to happen? Could you just imagine how much money the government can take from us because of this? Hypothetically, if the average person takes 500 photos a month, I'm sure some take more, some take less, if a Copyright registry charges \$5 per photo that's \$2,500 to register them with no guarantee they are safe. Oh, and there are more than one registries out there. So say you want to protect them with two registries, that's \$5,000 to protect your works and guess what, you're still not guaranteed. Pissed yet? It gets even better. If someone takes your creation and registers it before you, you could be illegally using your own creation. Does anyone else see a problem with this? This could never happen with our current laws.

If this bothers you then do something about it. Get up from your seat and contact your legislator. Go to http://www.usa.gov/Contact/Elected.shtml and let your voice be heard. Tell them it is wrong to take away your right to own something you've created. We should stay protected by Copyright law, not abused by it.

There are several articles online about this issue. I encourage everyone to look this up online. You can use search engines just type in "Orphan Works". There are also a few online petitions that you can look into as well. Please, don't let this bill become law.




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
